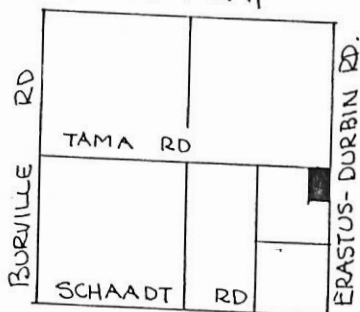


LOCATION PLAT

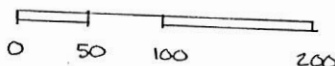
