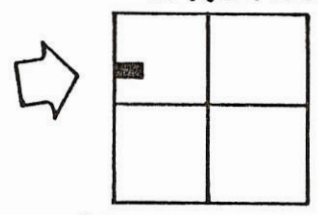


N. LINE ~ SEC. 18 & OREGON RD.

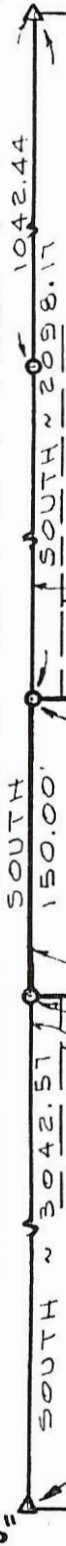
LOCATION SKETCH

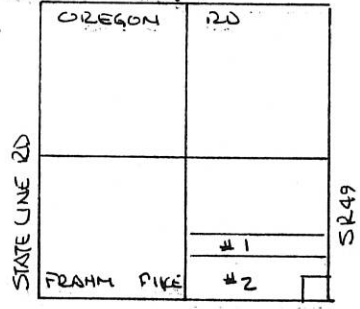

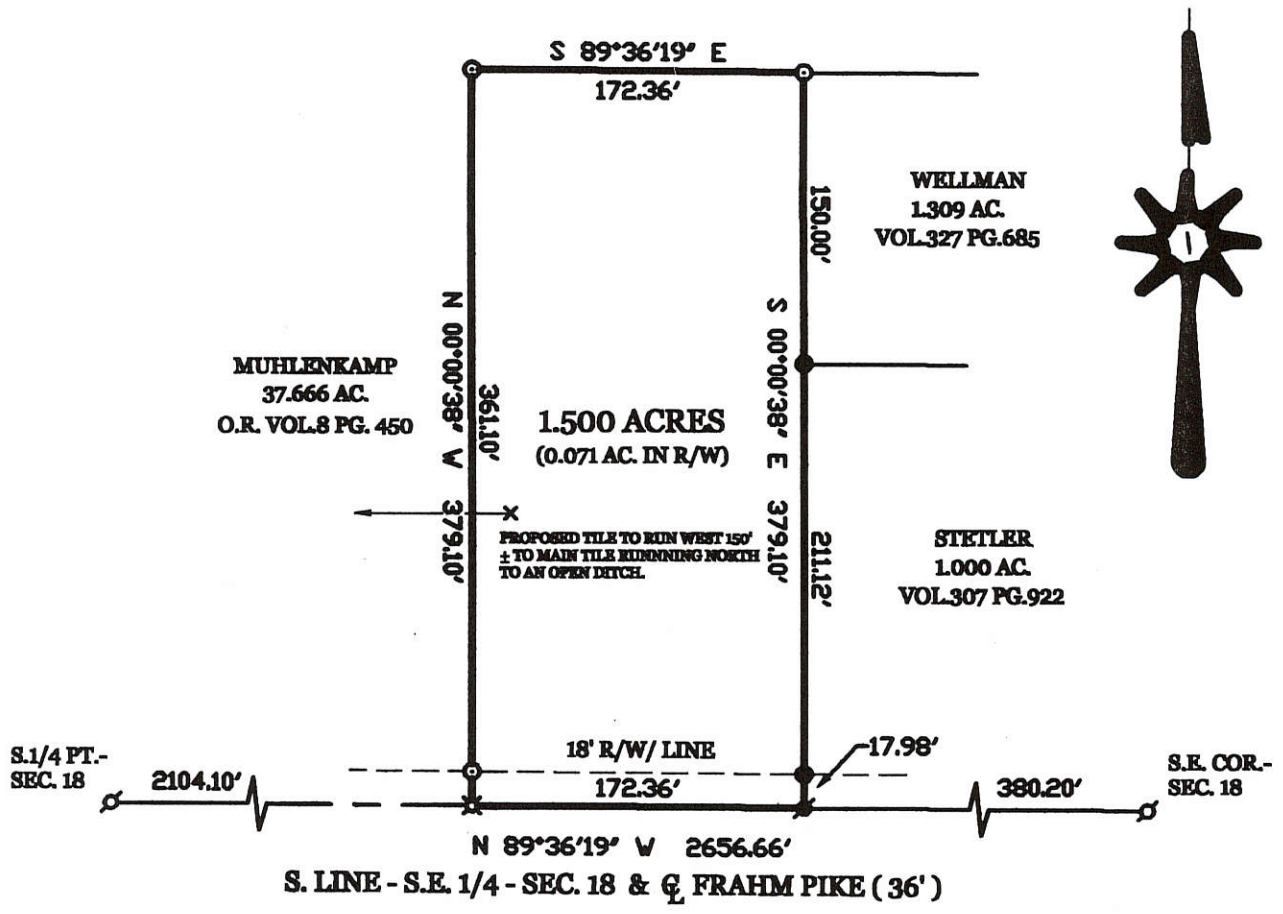
LOCATION SKETCH
