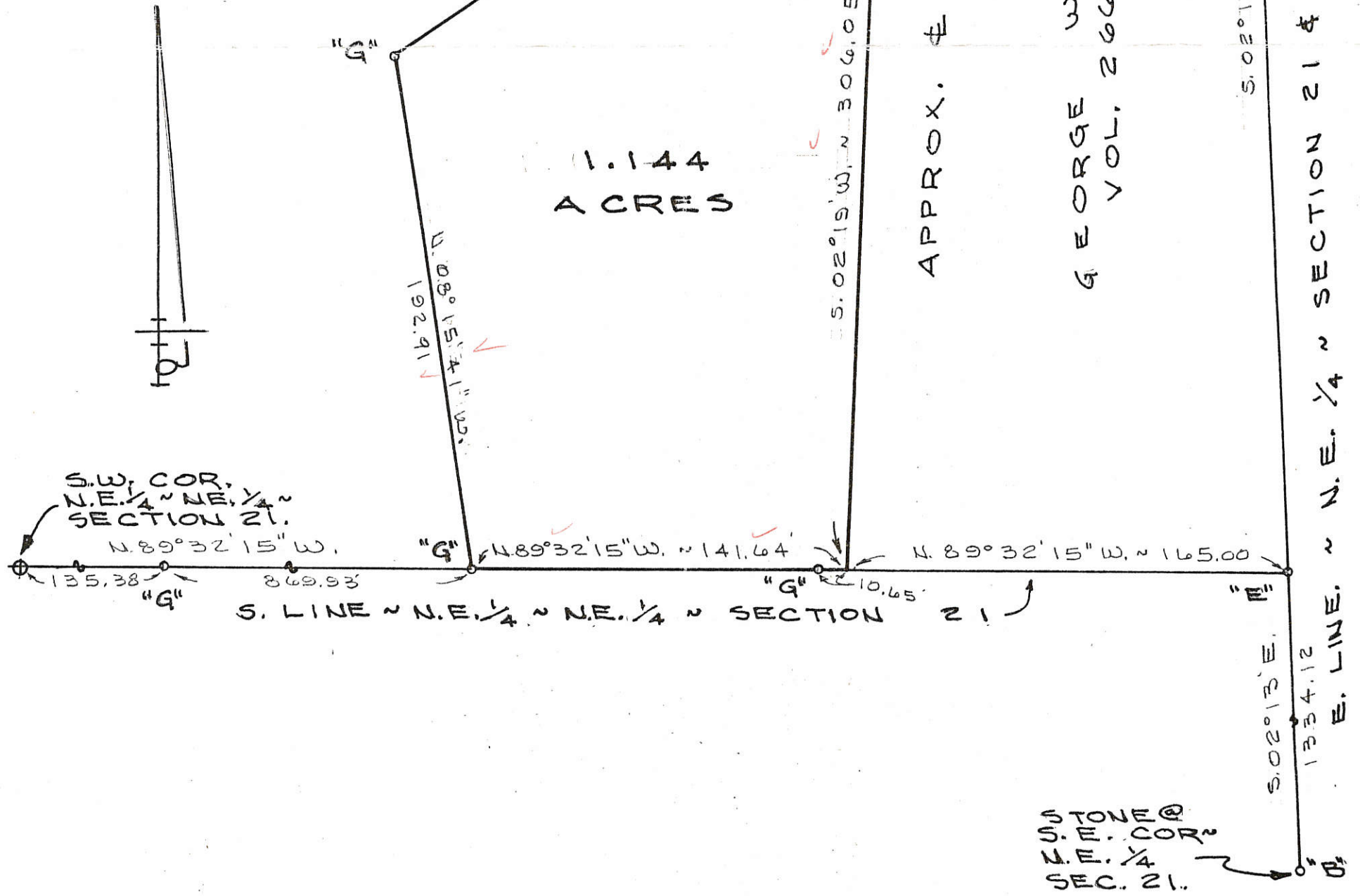

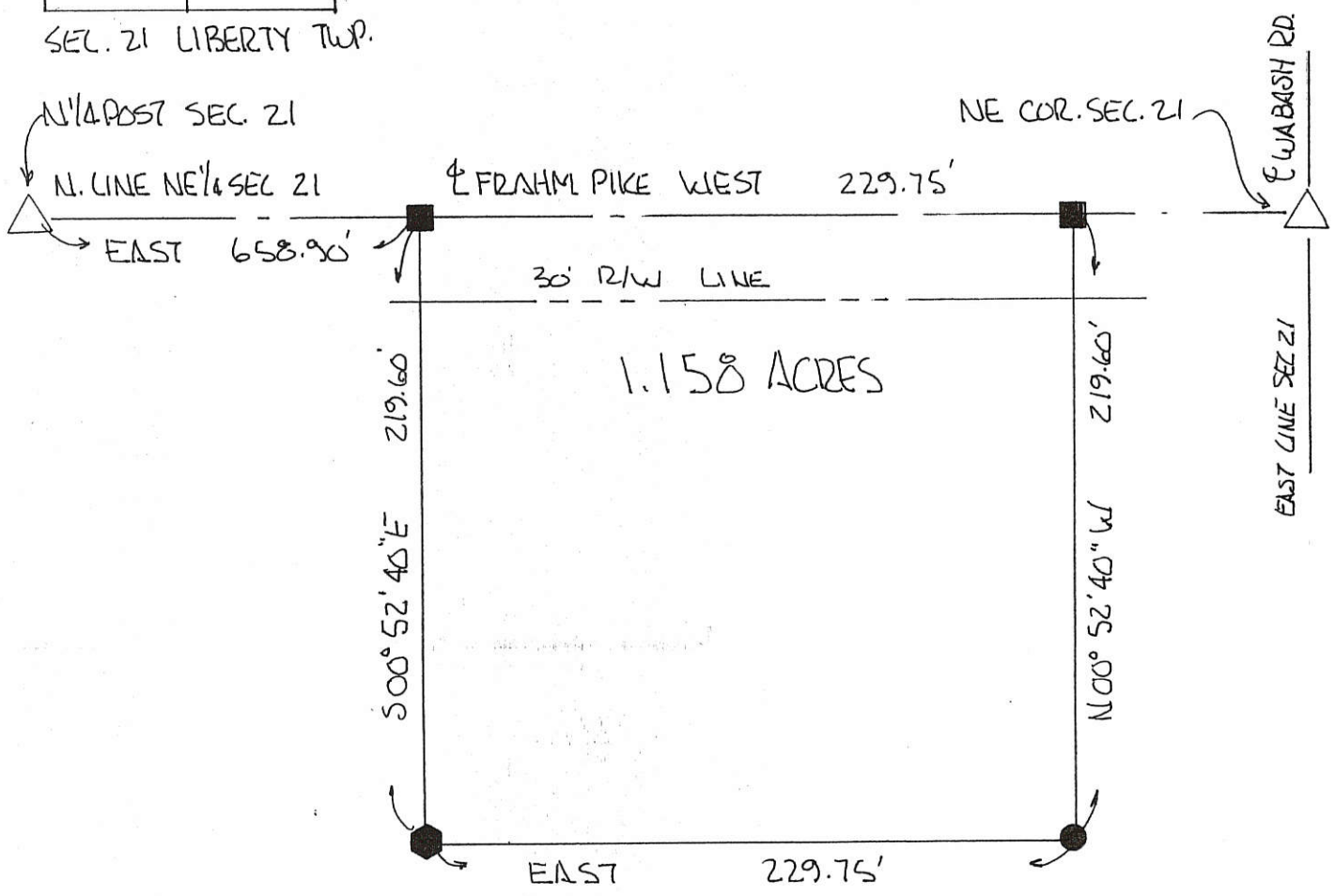


SEC. 21 LIBERTY TWP.

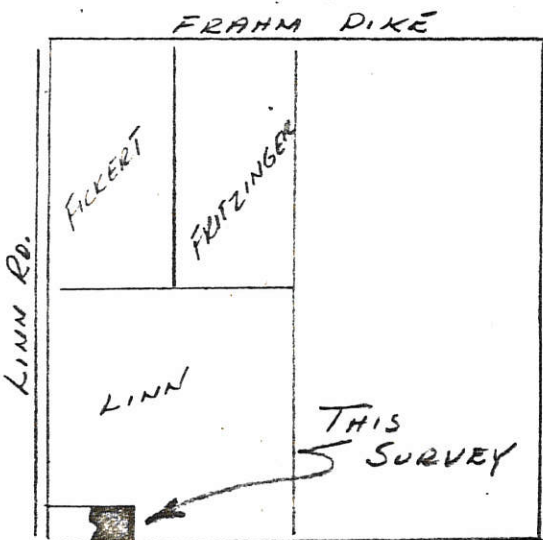
