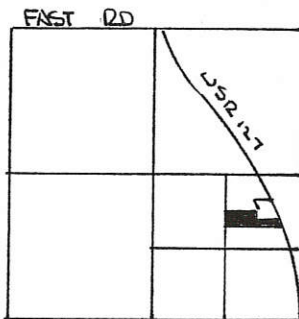

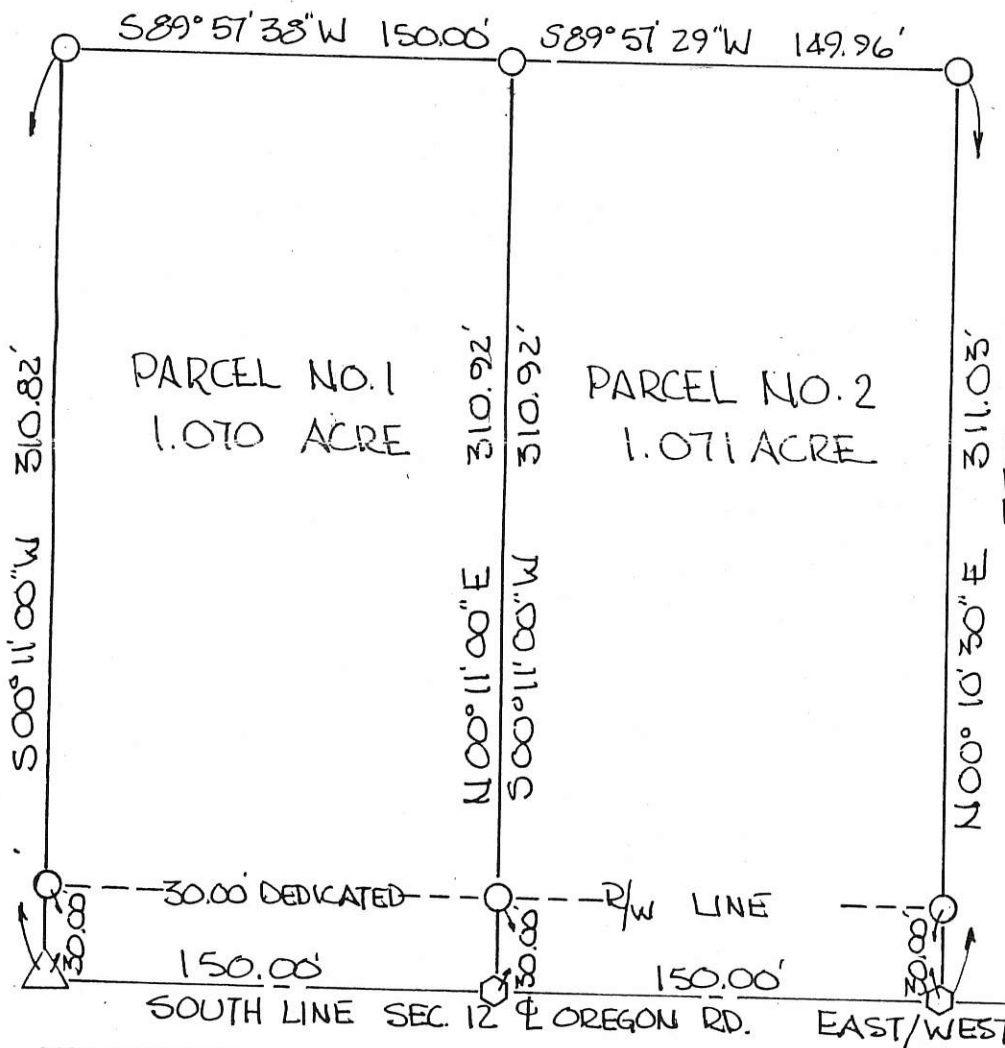
LOCATION PLAT
