LOCATION PLAT

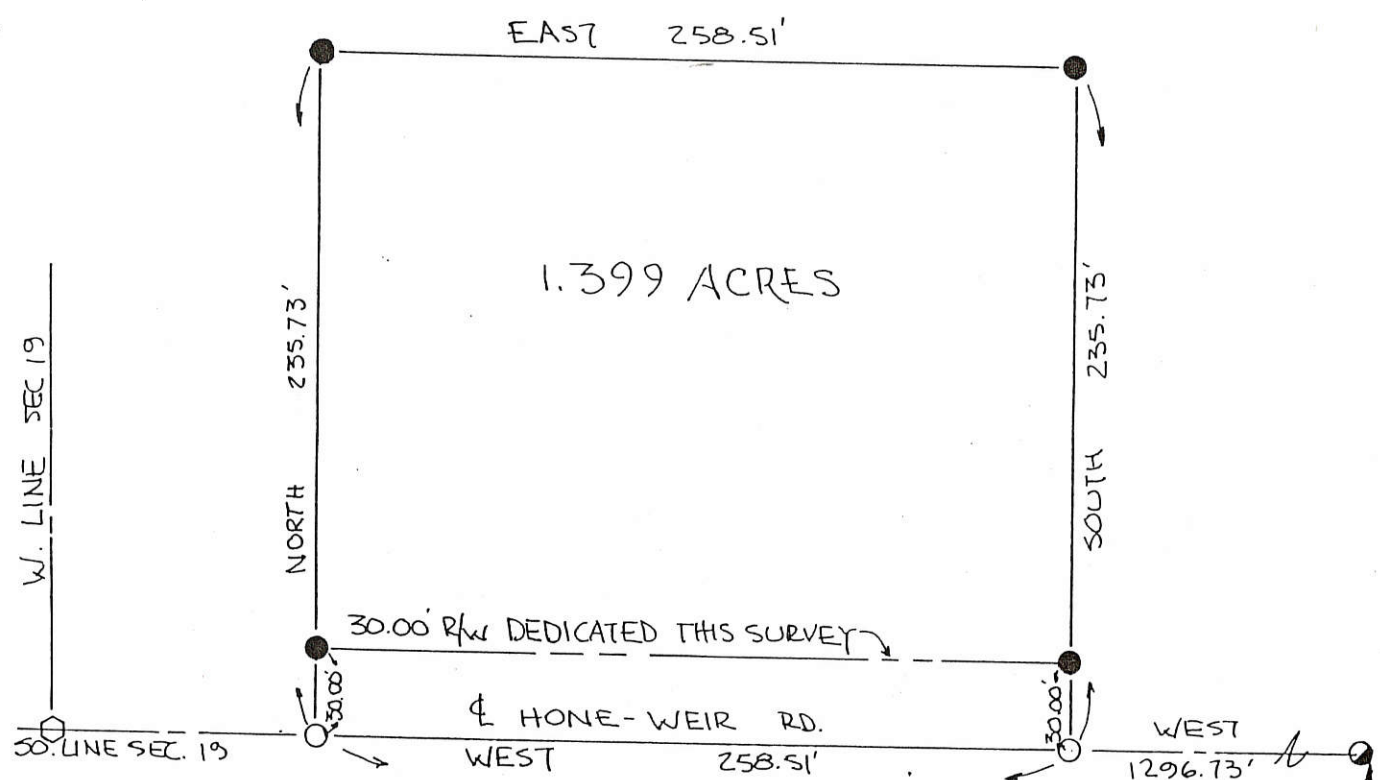
