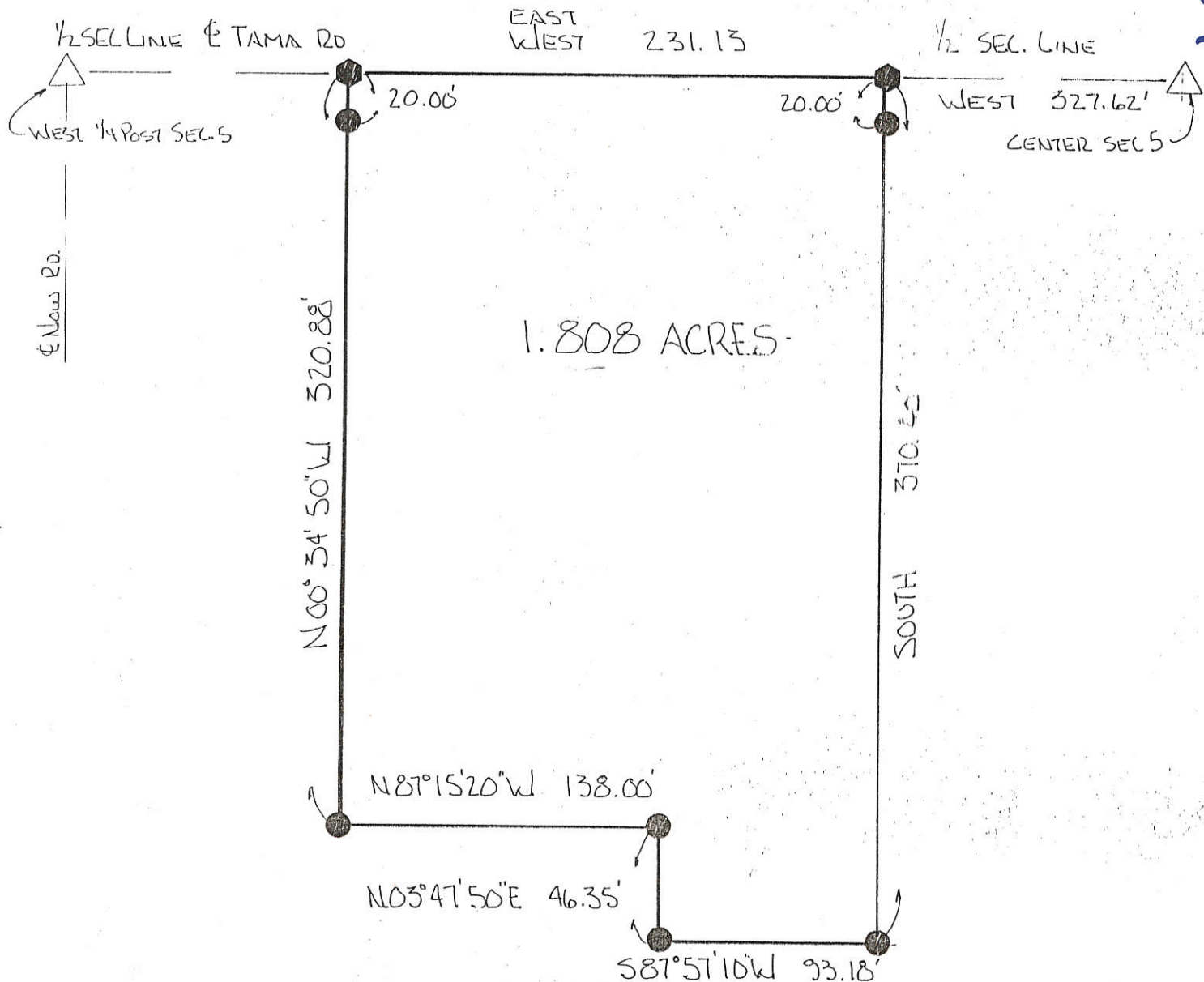


SEC. 5 HOPEWELL TWP.

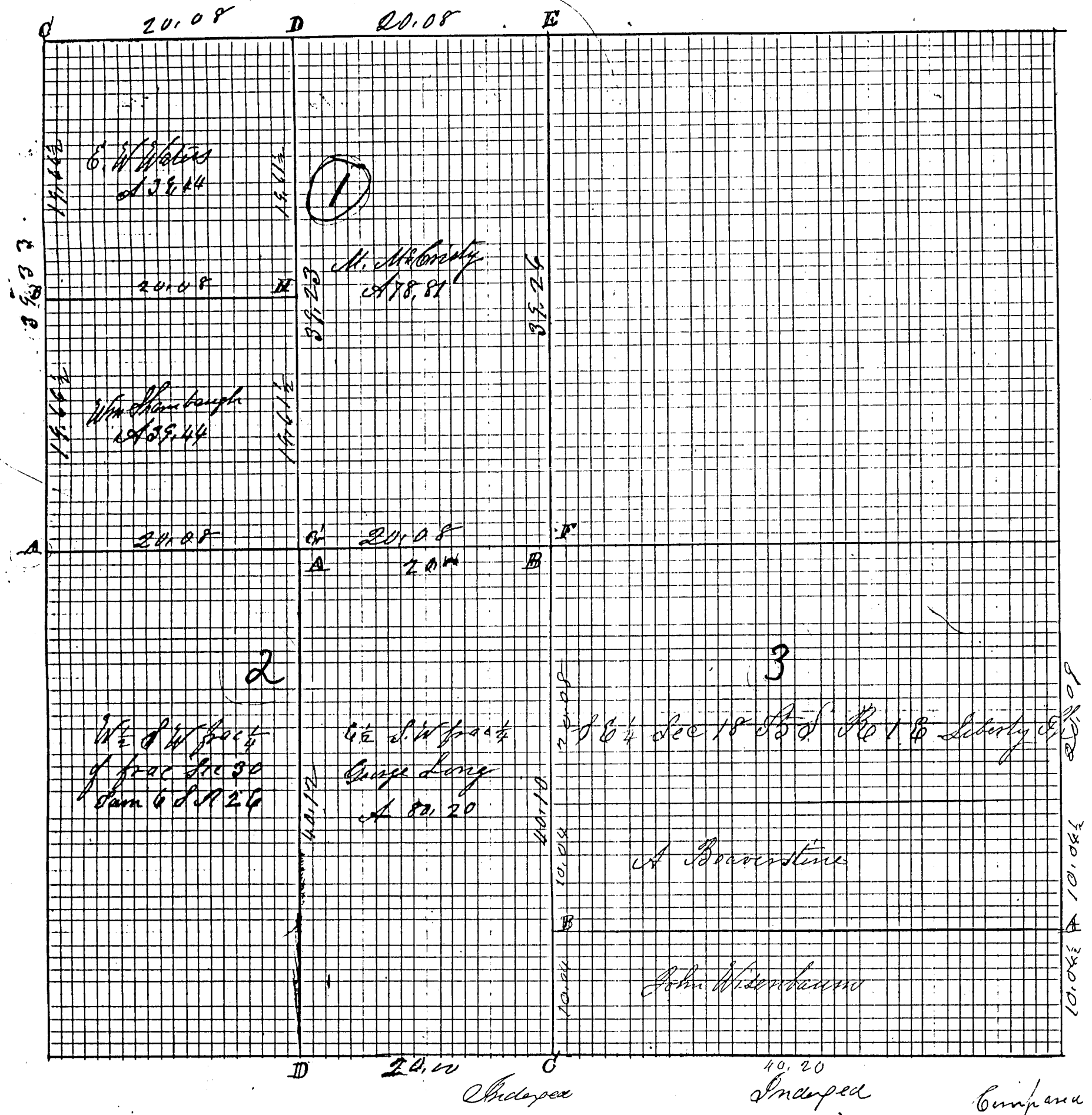
