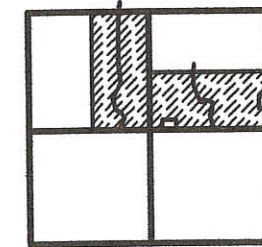




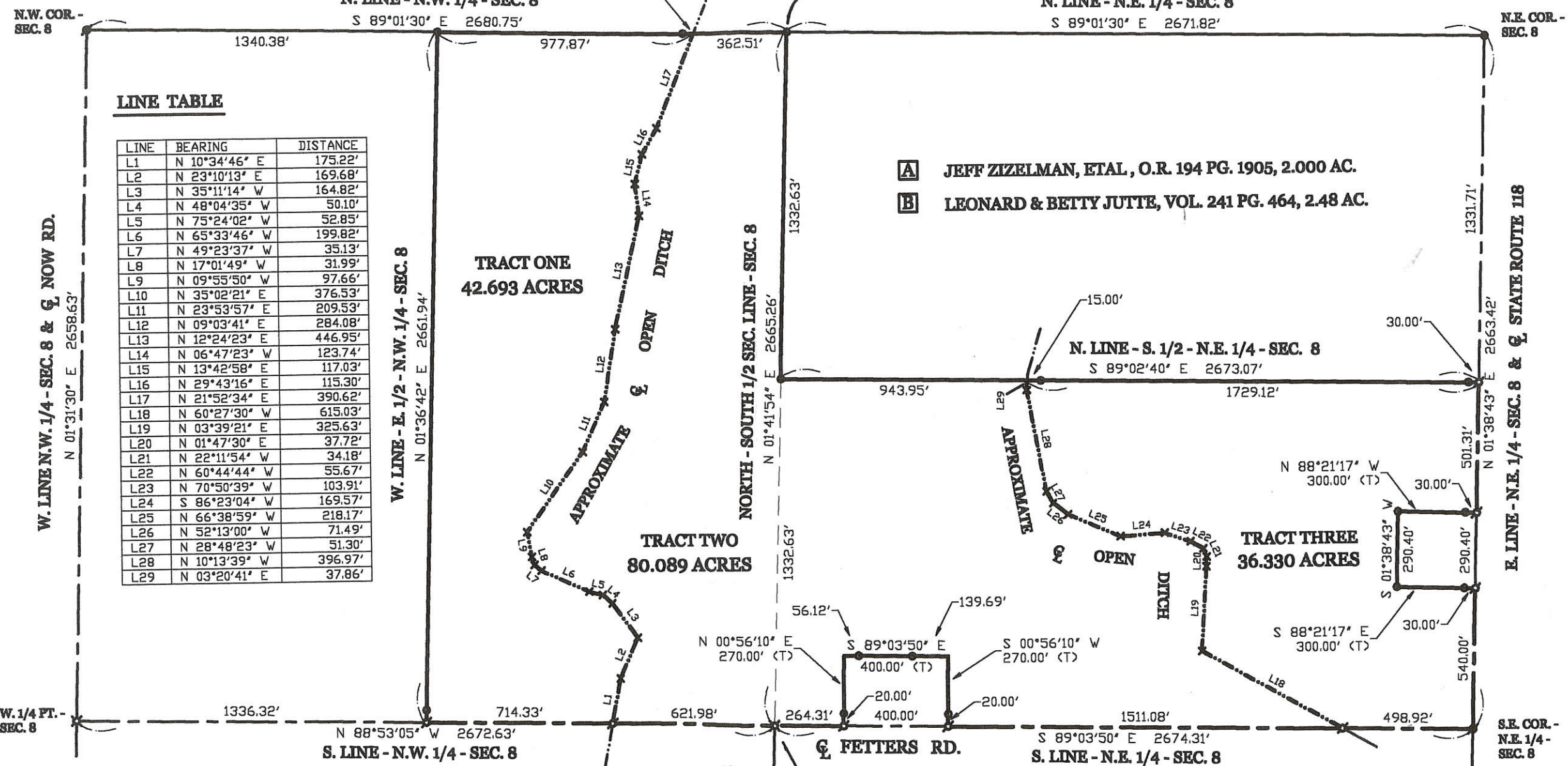

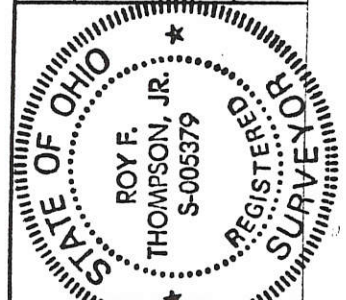


BEARINGS TURNED FROM NORTH LINE
