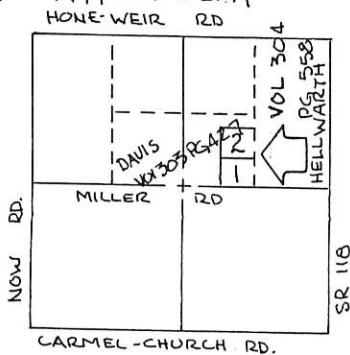

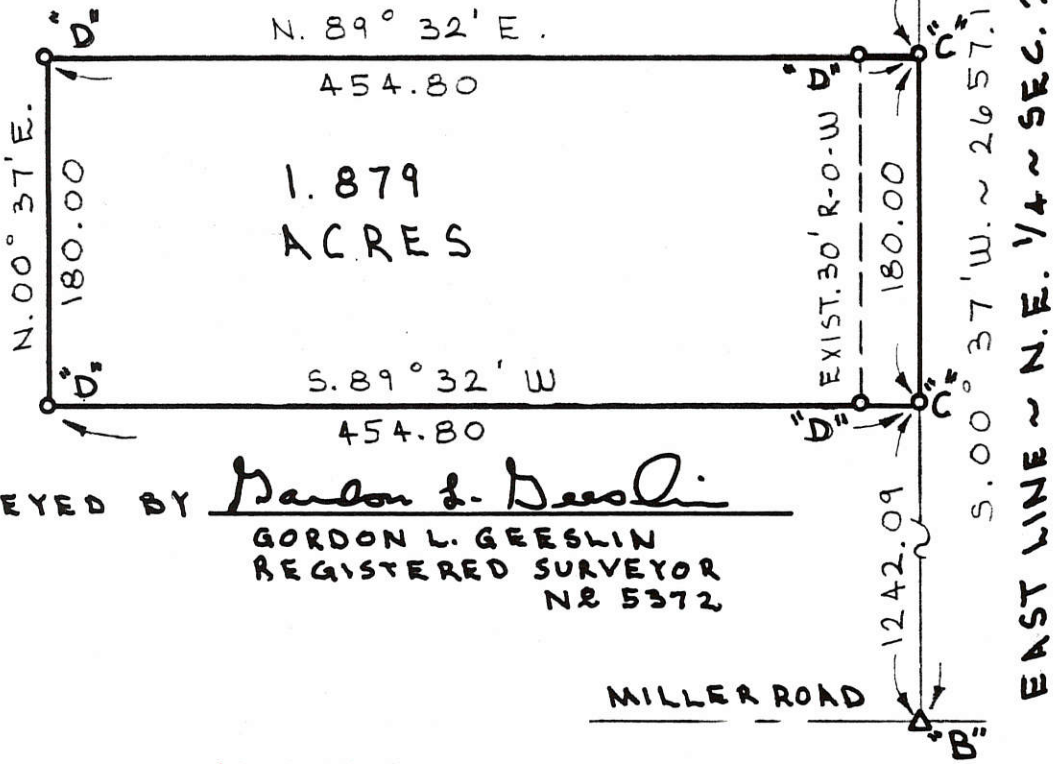
**LOCATION SKETCH**
