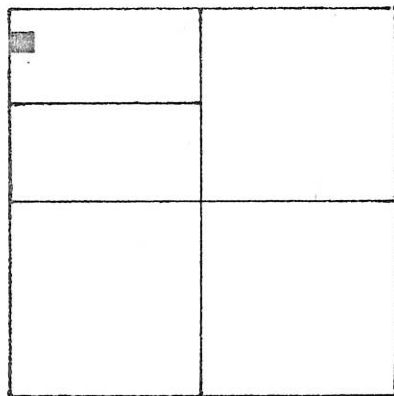


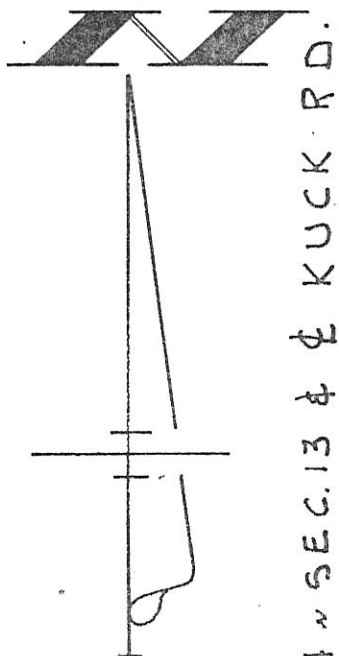
LOCATION SKETCH

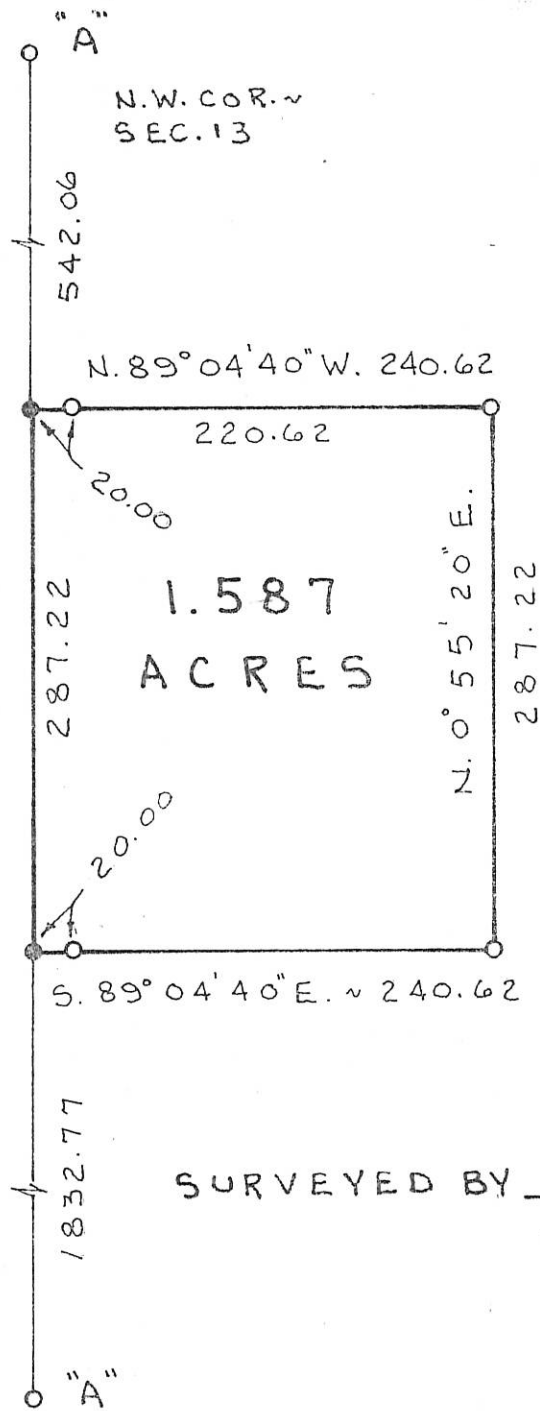

- B At east I find the Beech 15 S 56 1/2 W 19. standing green marked  
also the Beech 15 S 81 E 47 lying down all correct - stake marked  
White Oak 10 S 85 E 34.
- C At post I find both old bearing trees standing green all
