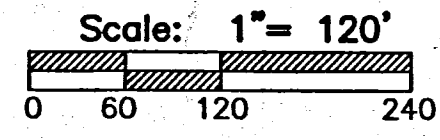
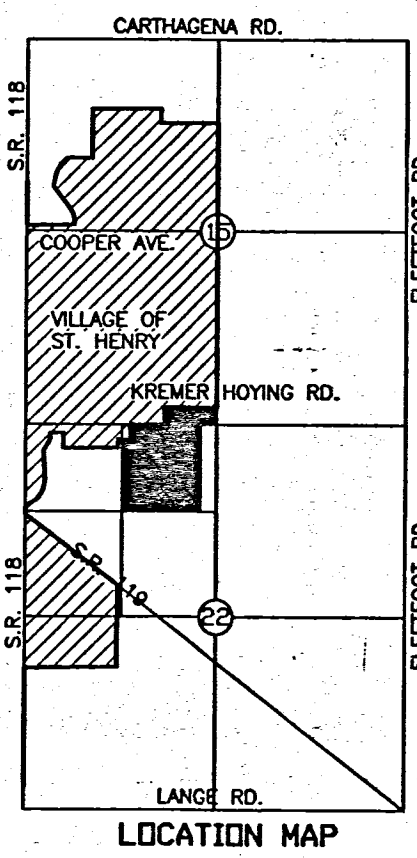
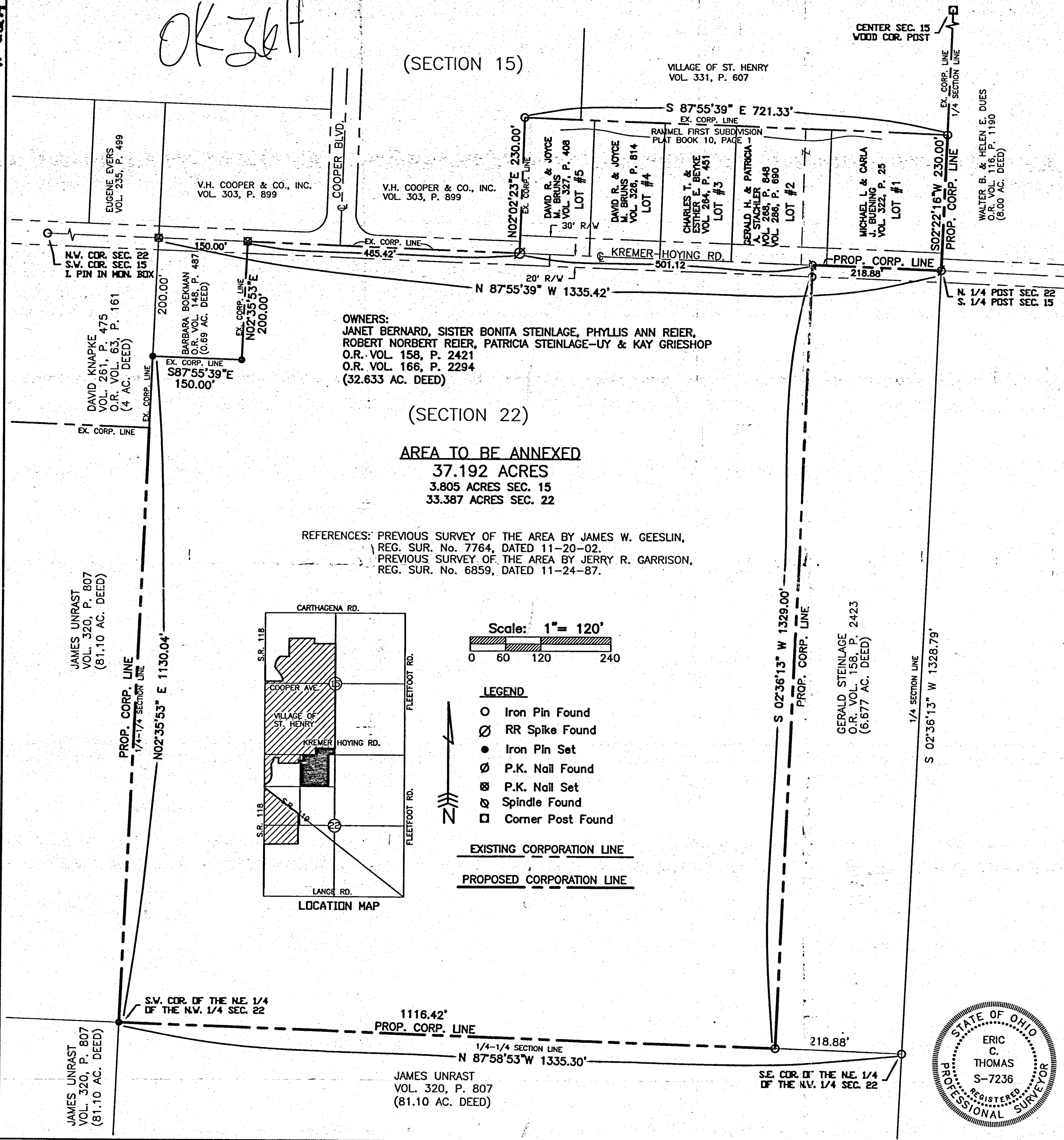
DESCRIPTION

Situated in the southwest quarter of Section fifteen (15) and the northwest quarter of Section twenty-two (22), Township Seven (7) South, Range Two (2) East, Granville Township, Mercer County, Ohio and bounded and described as follows:

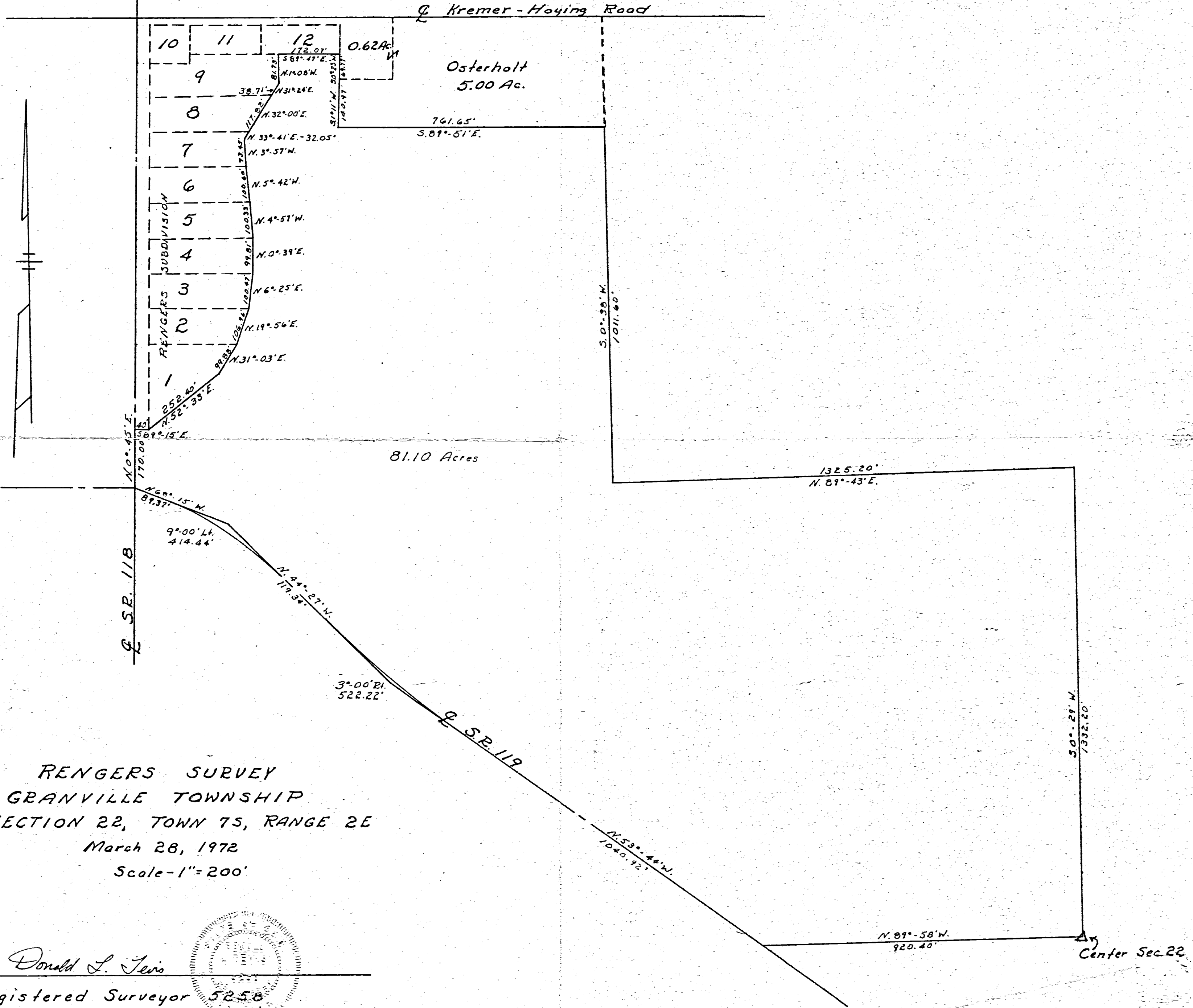
