Annexation Description

Being part of the Southeast (1/4) Section 10, T7S, R3E, Marion Township, Mercer County, Ohio and more definitely described as follows:

Be at a railroad spike set in the south line of said section 10 and at the existing West Corporation line of the Village of Chickasaw, Ohio and said spike being North 09°05'W along the south line of Section 10 a distance of one thousand three hundred thirty two (1332.00) feet from the Southeast corner of said section 10; thence continuing N 09°05'W on and along the south line of section 10 a distance of four hundred forty one and eighty hundredths (441.80) feet to a railroad spike; thence N 1°12' E a distance of two hundred ten (210.00) feet to a point; thence S 09°05' E a distance of one hundred seventy six and thirty five hundredths (176.35) feet to a point; thence N 1°12' E a distance of two hundred eighty four and sixty hundredths (284.60) feet to an existing iron pin; thence S 09°05' E a distance of two hundred sixty and fifty six hundredths (260.56) feet to an existing iron pin; thence S 00°38' W a distance of four hundred ninety four and sixty hundredths (494.60) feet to the place of beginning.
