

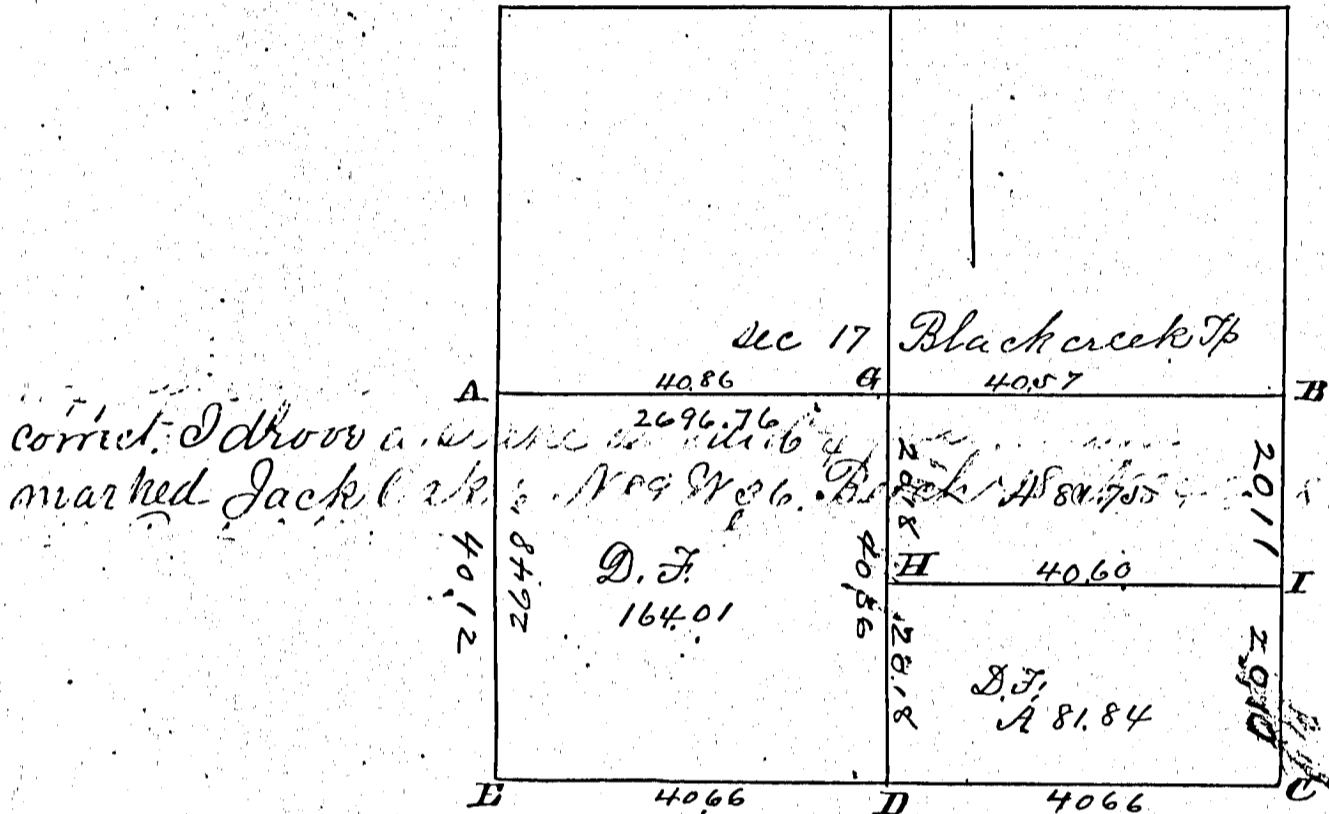

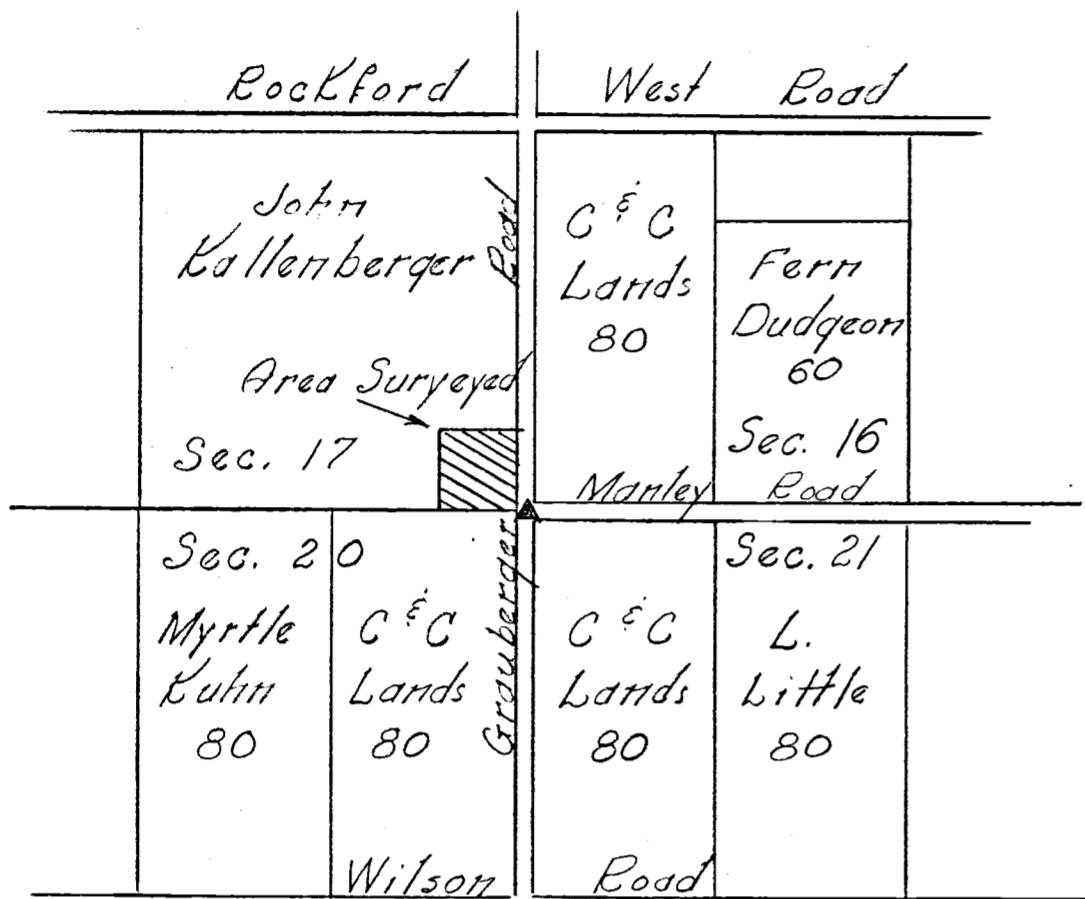

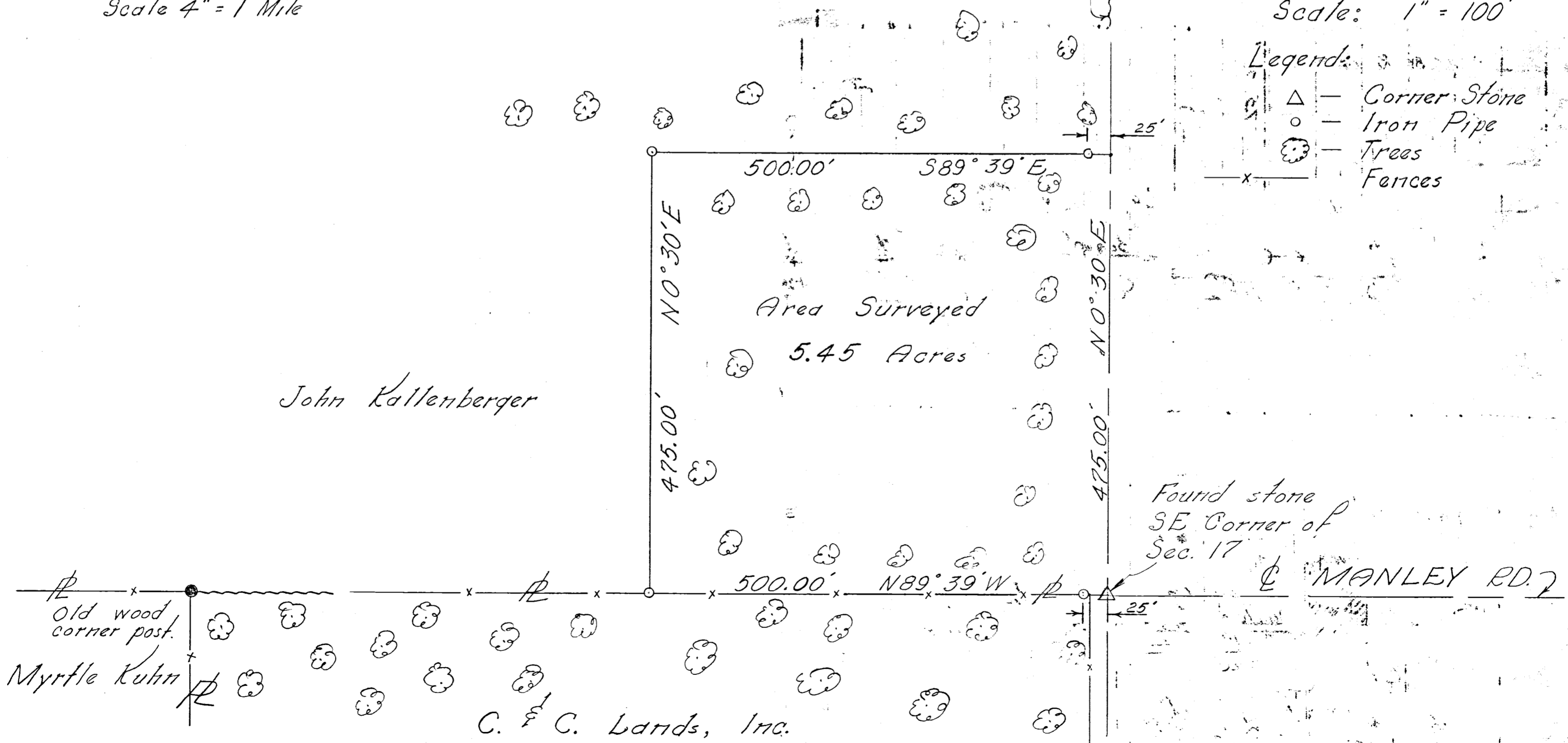
Location Plat

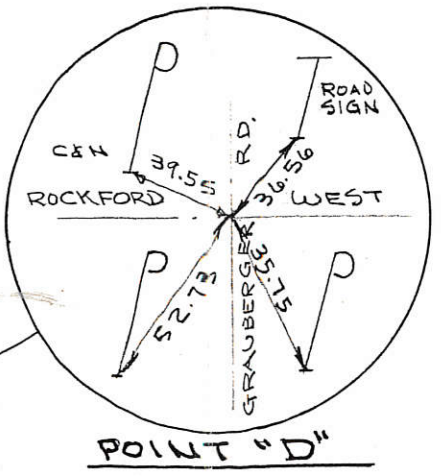
LOCATION SKETCH

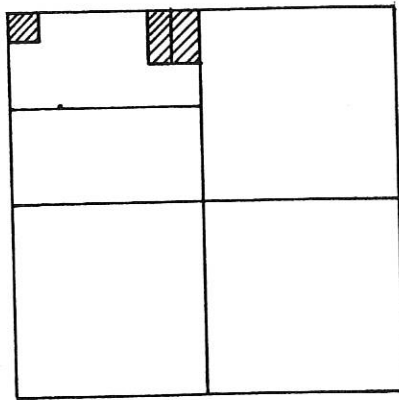

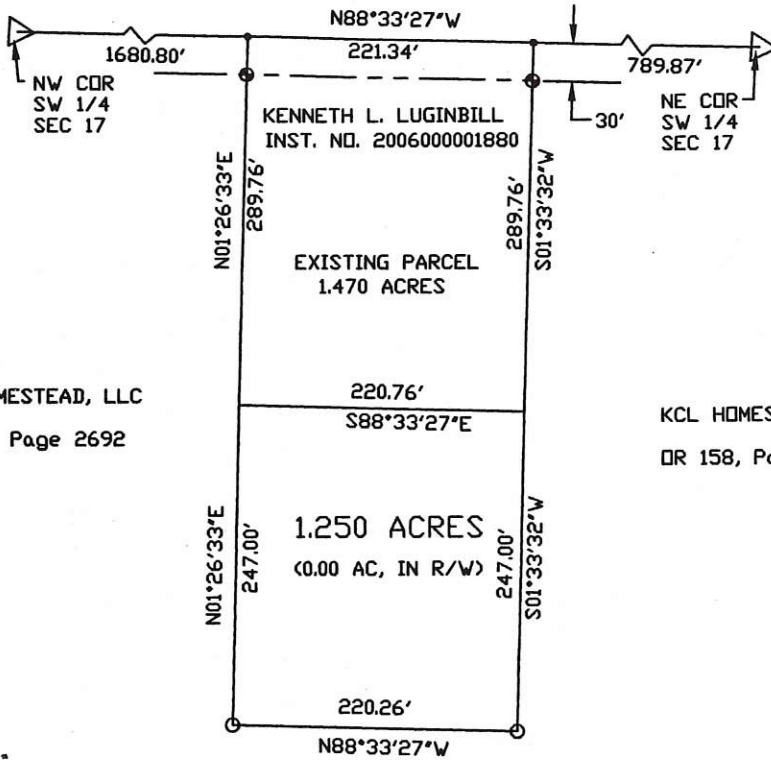

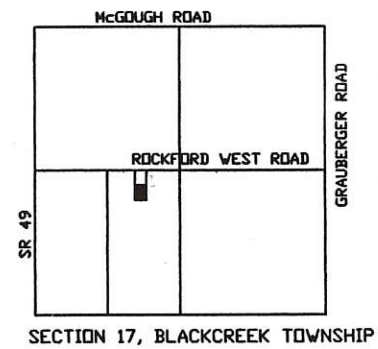
