ASSUMED EAST-WEST.



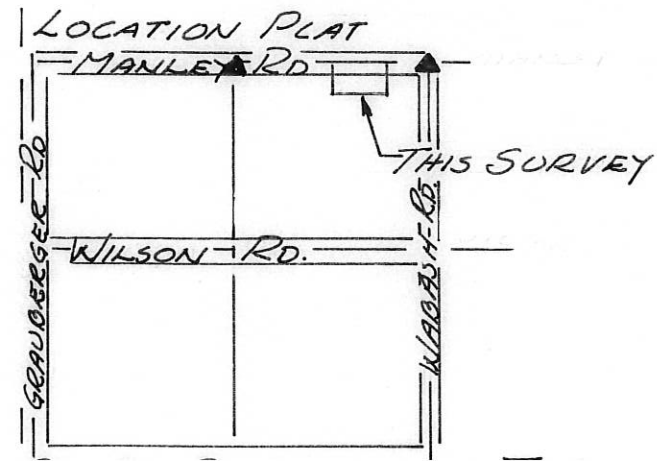
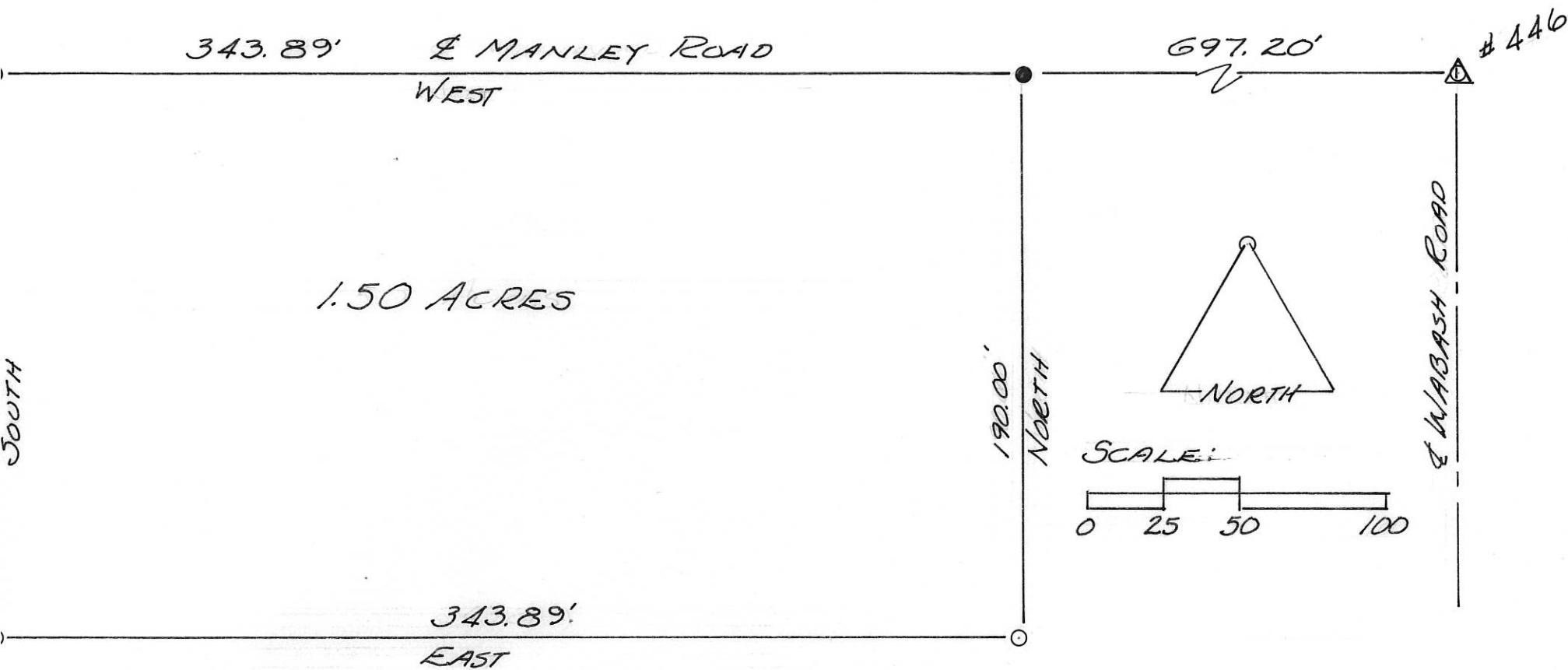

Description:

Commencing at the west quarter point of section 21, Town 4 South, Range 1 East, Blackcreek Township, Mercer County, Ohio, said point being the point of intersection of the Grauberger Road and the Wilson Road and also defined by a railroad spike set flush with the roadway surface, thence east on and along the centerline of the Wilson Road a distance of two hundred thirty and ninety-five hundredths (230.95) feet to a railroad spike as the point of beginning, thence continuing on and along the centerline of the Wilson Road a distance of four hundred forty-one and five hundredths (441.05) feet to a railroad spike set flush with the roadway surface, thence south one hundred forty-five and forty-eight hundredths (145.48) feet to a reinforced concrete monument, thence west a distance of three hundred ninety-seven and sixty-four hundredths (397.64) feet to a point on the centerline of an open ditch, thence north 11° 37' West a distance of one hundred fifty-one and eighty-two hundredths feet to the point of beginning.

Afore described tract contains one and forty hundredths (1.40) acres, more or less, and is subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

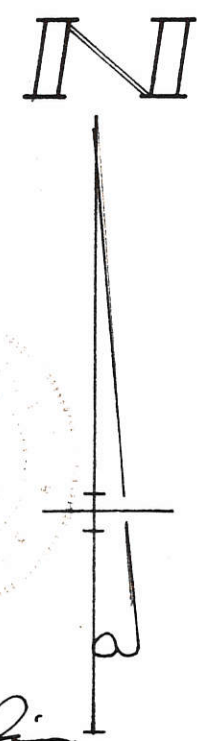
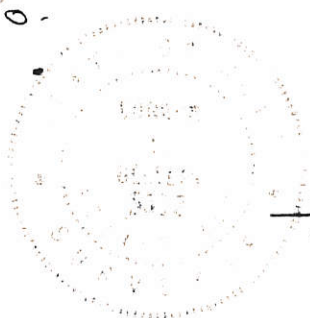
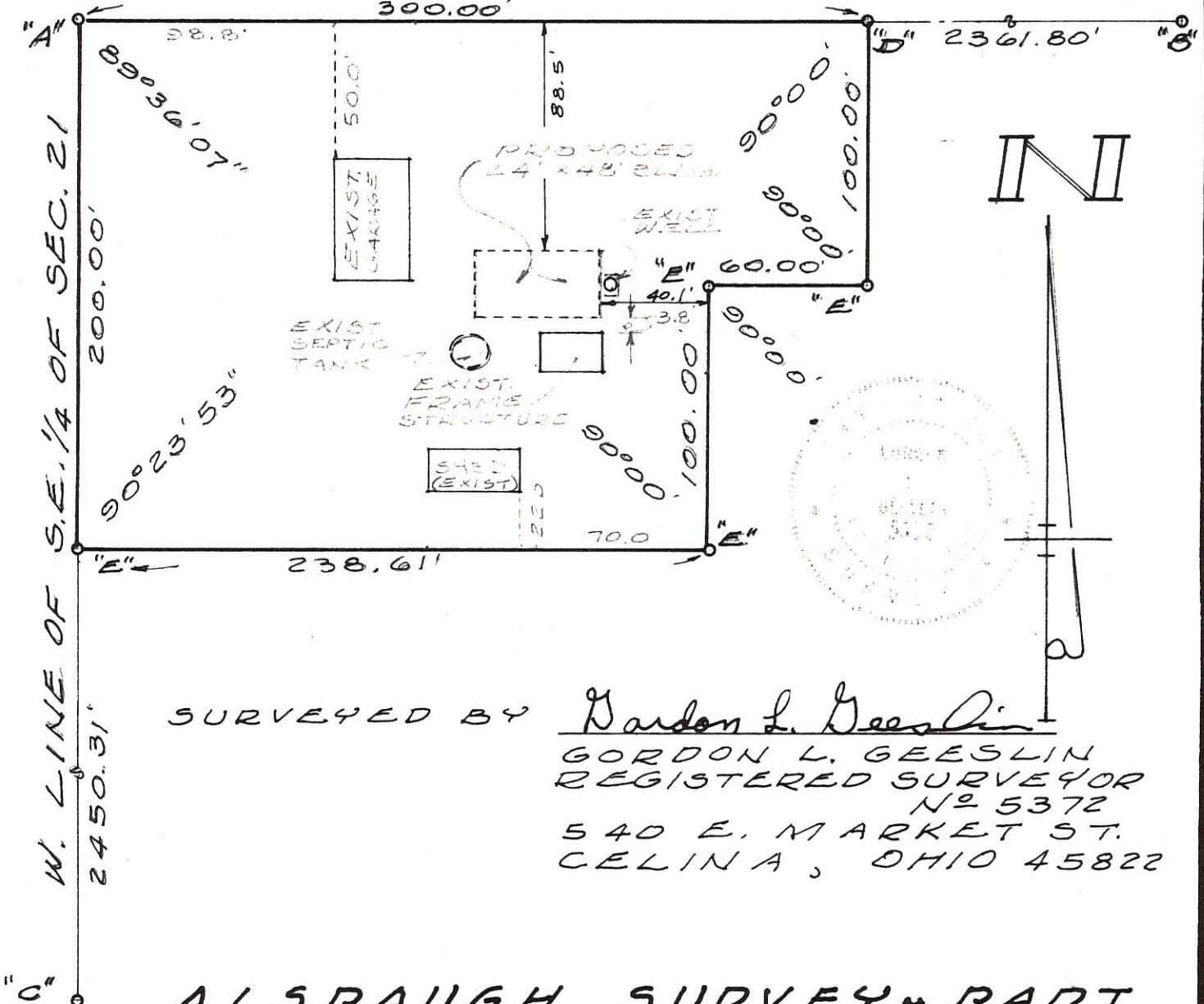
