

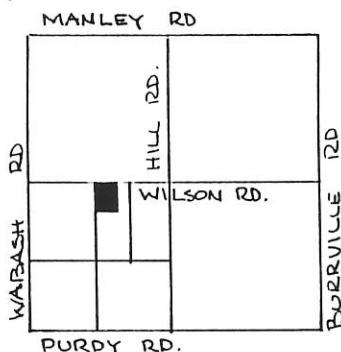
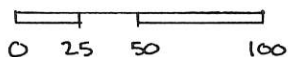

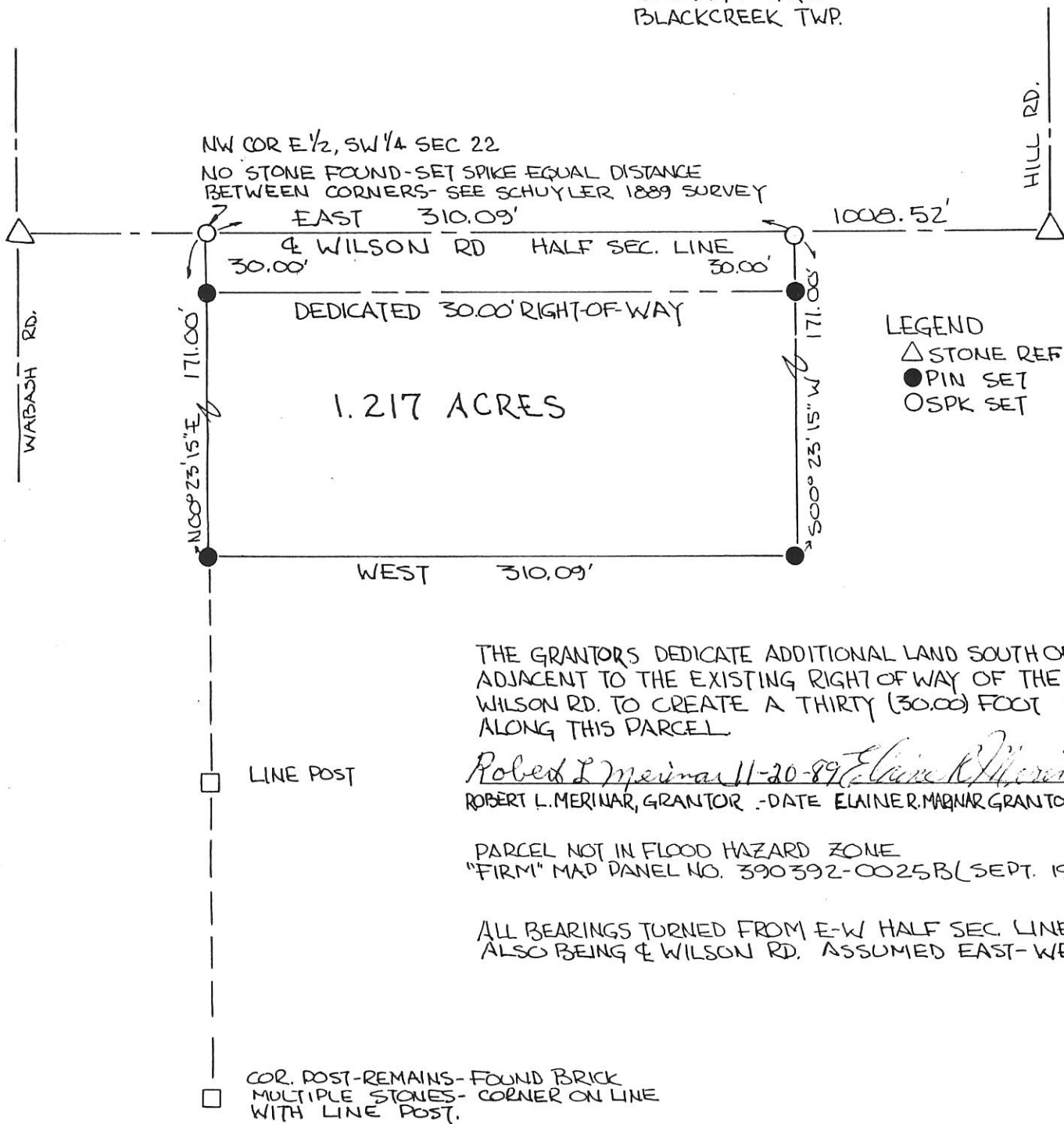
LOCATION PLAT
