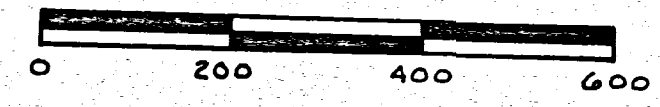

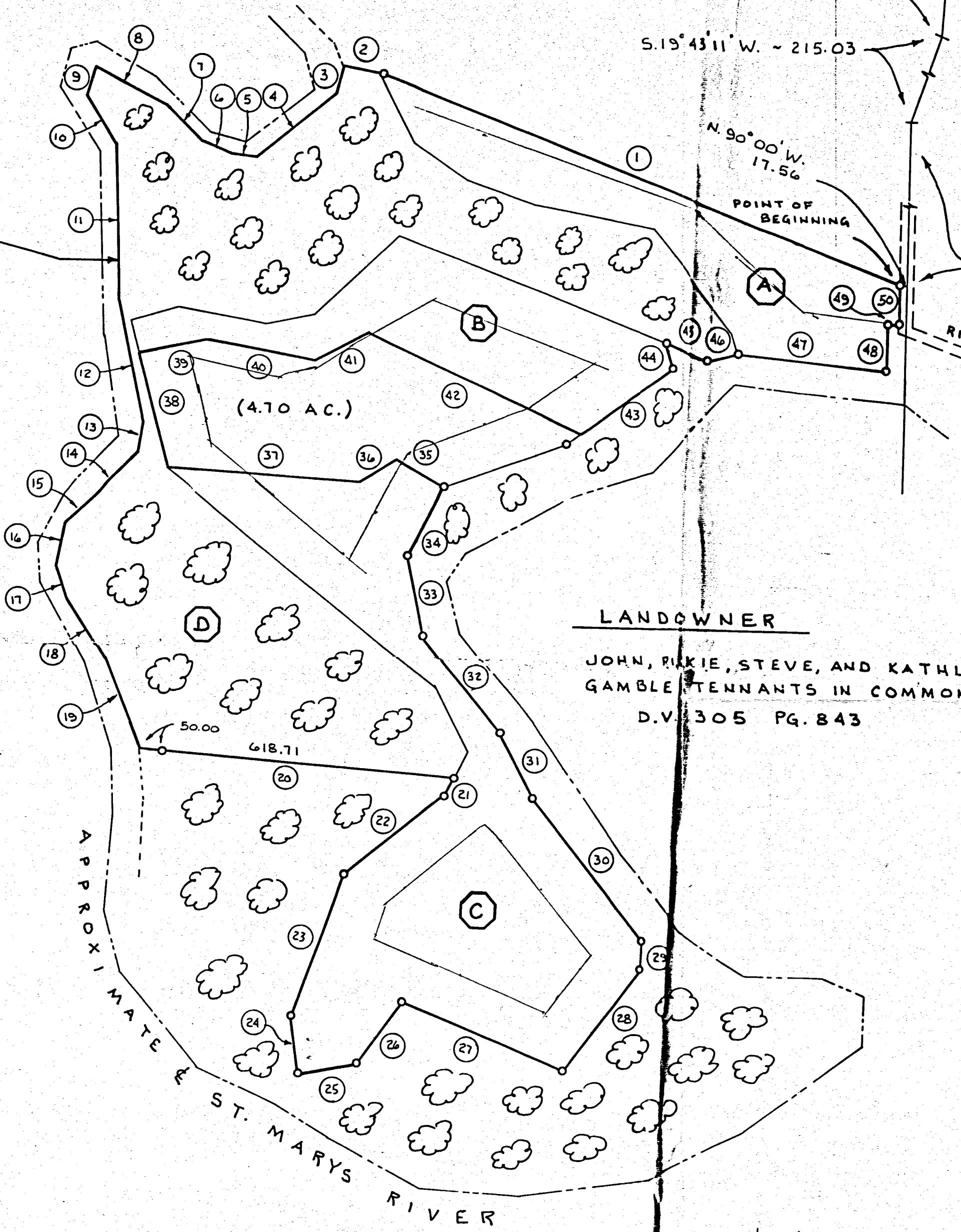

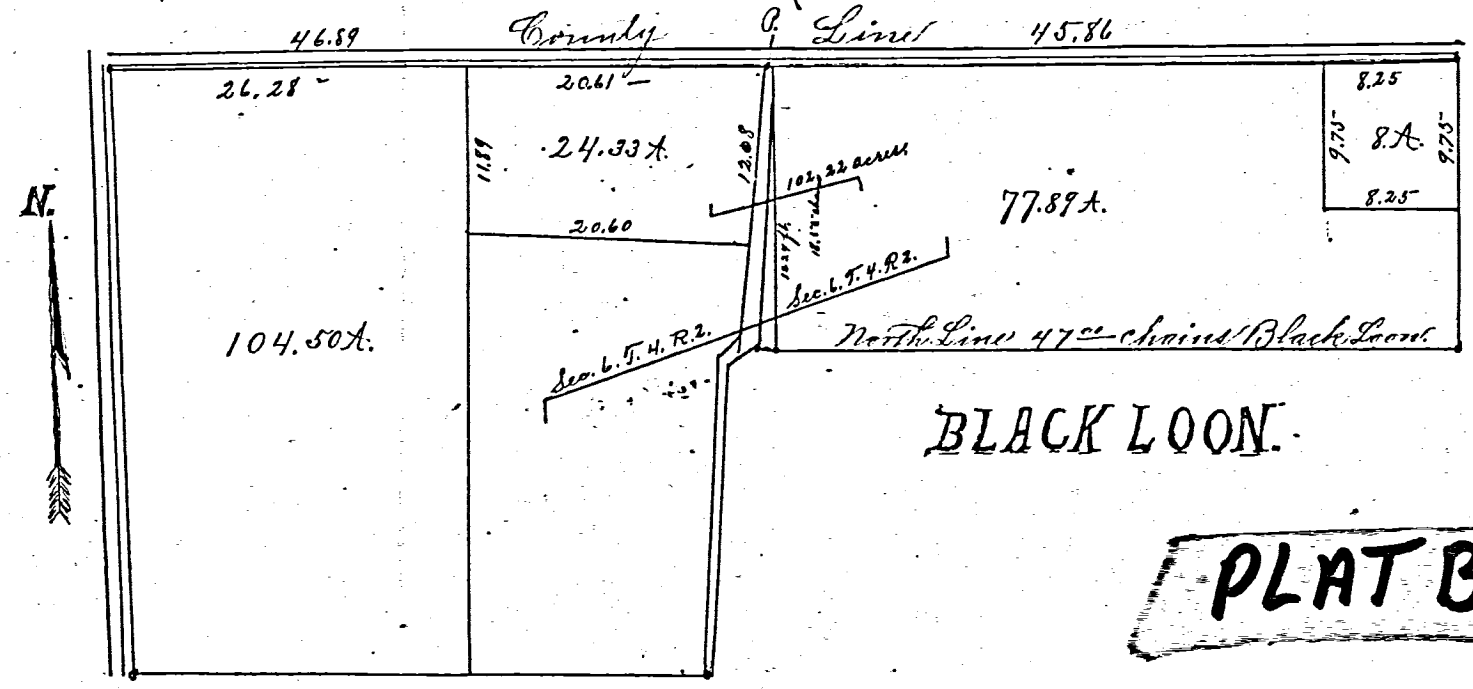

Plat showing the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Northwest fractions of fractional Section Six (6) Town four (4) Range two (2) East, and their relation to the Black Loon Indian Reservation. Scale 8 chains to the inch surveyed December 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> 1927. Beginning for the North  $\frac{1}{4}$  One fourth said section at the center of the two roads, thence East 45.86 chains to the Northeast corner thereof; Thence South with the east line to the corner a distance of 18.50 chains; Thence West on the line between said fraction and said Black Loon Reservation 47<sup>00</sup> chains; Thence North to the place of beginning containing 85.89 acres in the whole fraction, deducting the 8 acre tract leaves 77.89 acres now in possession. The other tract begins at said North  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. 57 West 20.61 chains; Thence South 11.89 chains; Thence East 20.61; Thence North 12.08 to the beginning containing 24.33 acres in all 102.22 acres. The measurements were along well established lines all of which certify to be correct to the best of my knowledge. *J. R. Randaugh* Surveyor.

Remarks: It will be noticed that the West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Northwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  is 26.28 chains while the East  $\frac{1}{2}$  of Northwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  is but 20.61 chains. That is the way they have been having and occupying it for some 50 years.

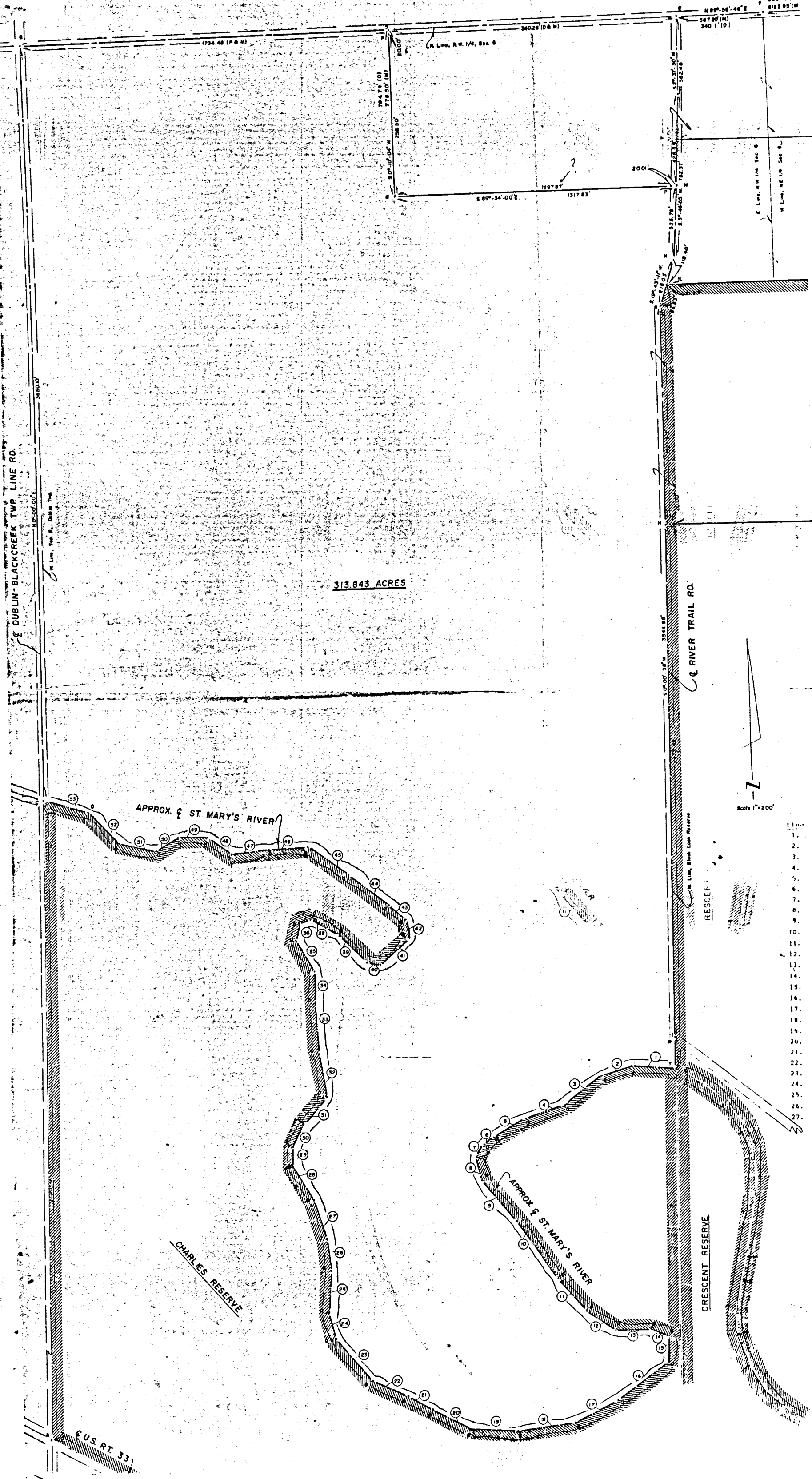
Part of Section 6, T. 4, R. 2, Dublin Tp. <sup>9th</sup> and their Relation to Black Loon Reservation.
