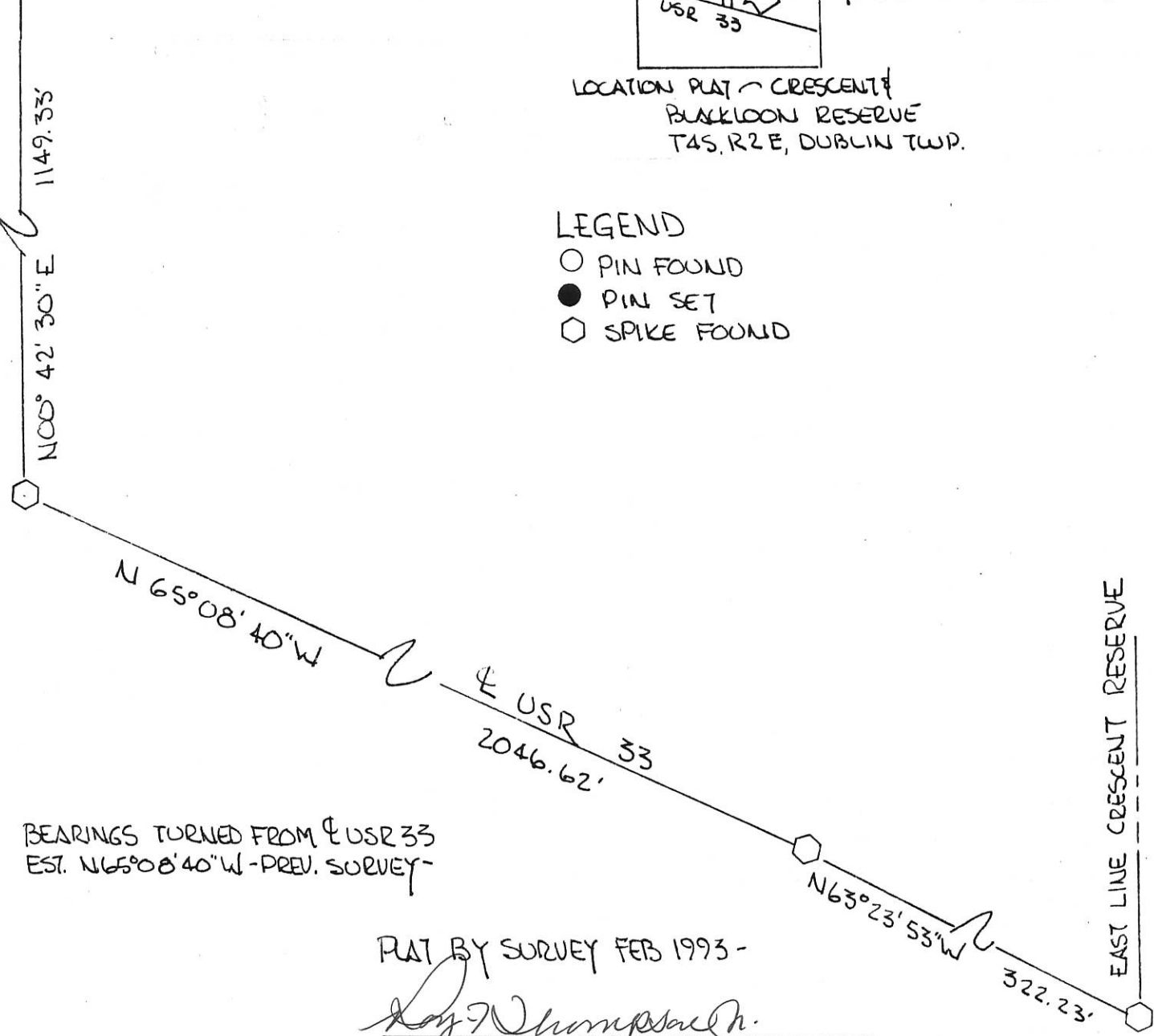
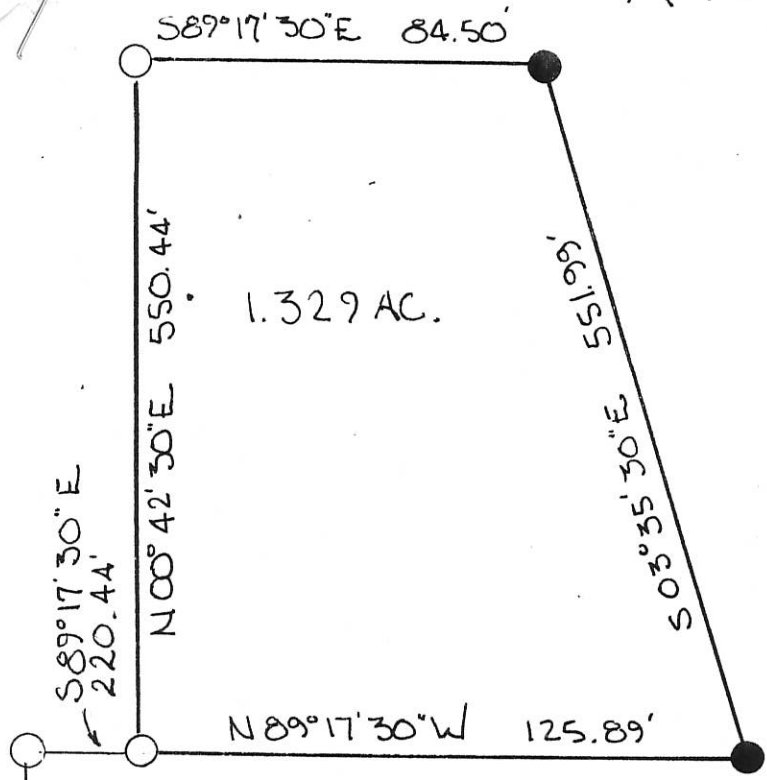
LOCATION PLAT.

NOTES

- 1) The location of the old channel may not agree with that of former deeds, due to the fact that existing field evidence is sparse.
- 2) This line of occupancy is north of the line of record by 9.6 feet at the west end and 13.7 feet at the east end; however, deed volume 133, page 34, (Frisinger to Beerbower and Buel) does call for a "Post" at the east end and at the west end of this line. There is a post at each end of the occupied line and, if they were determined to be the original Posts, they could establish intent. Legal advice is recommended.
- 3) Jacob Hardin acquired title to this tract by deed recorded in deed volume 126, page 20, dated December 27, 1932. When he transferred land to Herbert Frisinger by deed recorded in deed volume 126, page 495, dated August 8, 1934, he did not include this tract. This seems to have been an oversight. Legal advice is recommended.
- 4) This area has always been used by the Frisinger chain of title and has been included in prior descriptions. The land is technically in Shane's Reserve. The area is included in this survey, however, legal advice is recommended.

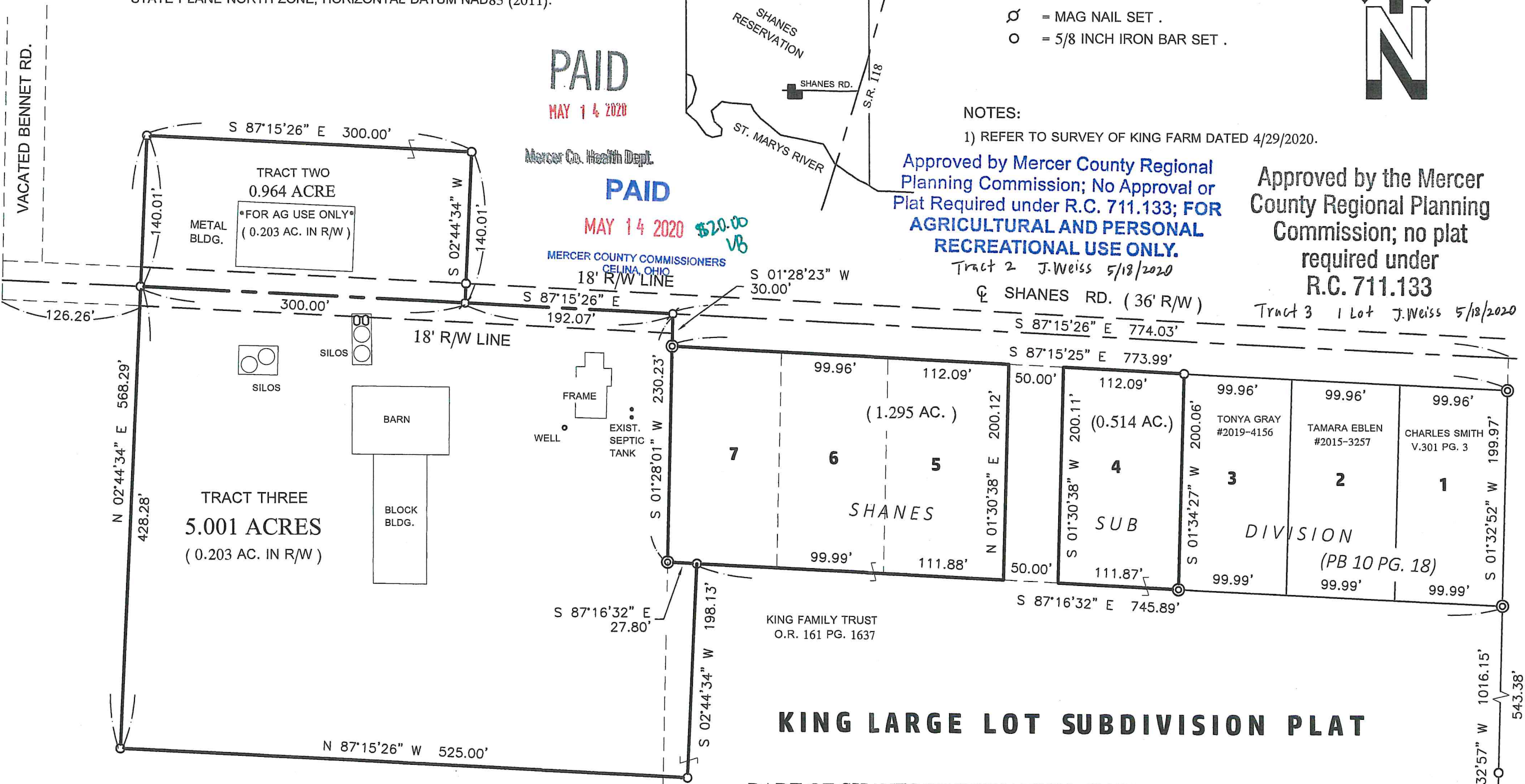
