This Survey was made to determine the amount of land in sec 20-4-3 N of the St Marys River. The original notes call for 143.81 acres. There is only 133.18 including the river, & 112.80 excluding the river. The survey was also made to find if there was not more taken under the deed for the west 1/2 of said 1/4 than legally belonged to it. The deed describes by running from the west along the N line of the sec to within 100 of the N 1/4 of same and thence S to the river. This fixes the boundary - the natural boundary controls, and not the no. of acres. I find 51.36 acres in Mr. Lampy's part including the river and 41.32 acres excluding the river. Mr. Schuyler former Co Surveyor found only 38.80 in this E part, but his work in fact all the computations of this land have been illegally made. The statute requires them to be made by latitude and departure while they have been made by multiplying by average lengths. (see page 67 old record)

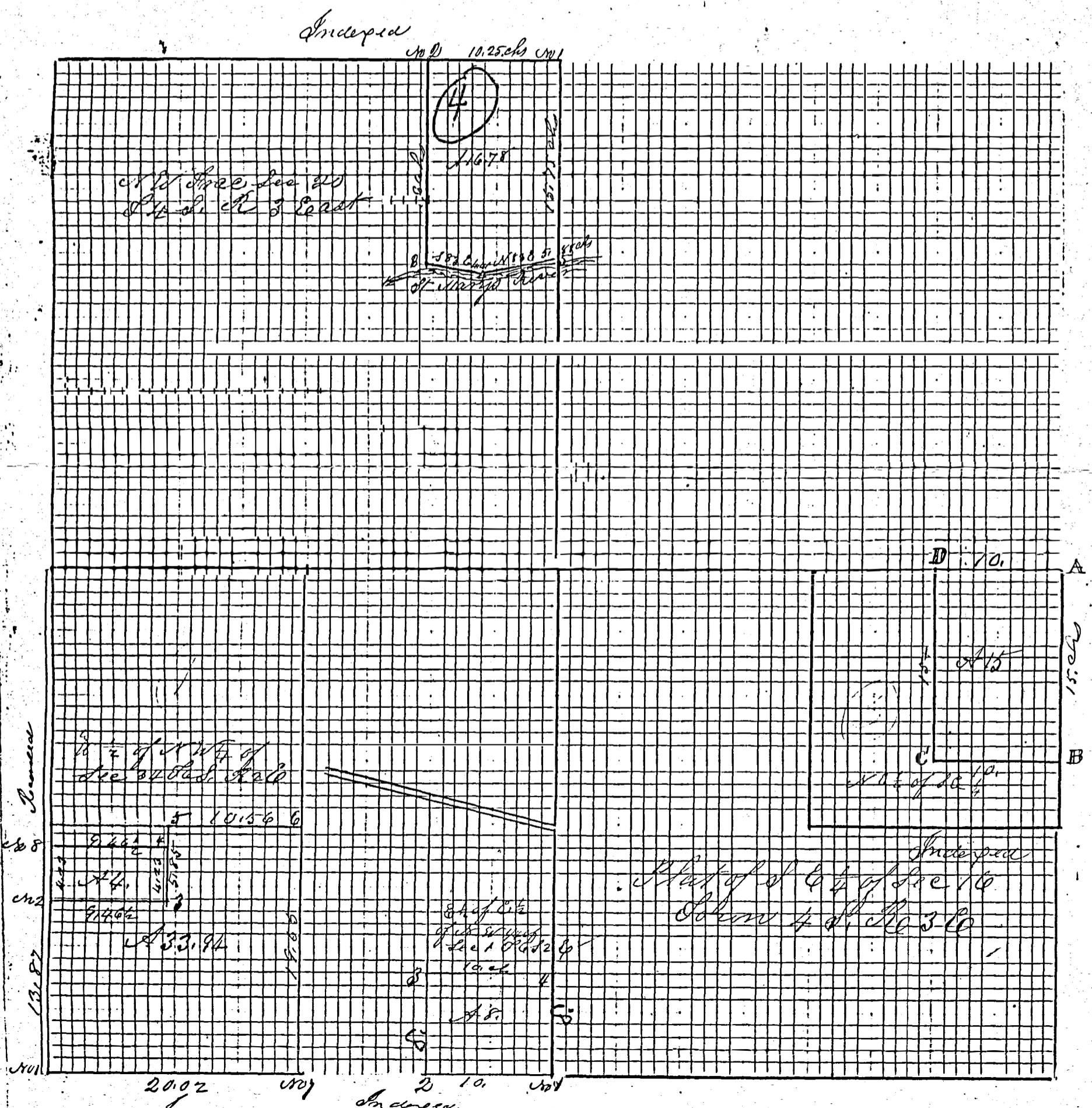

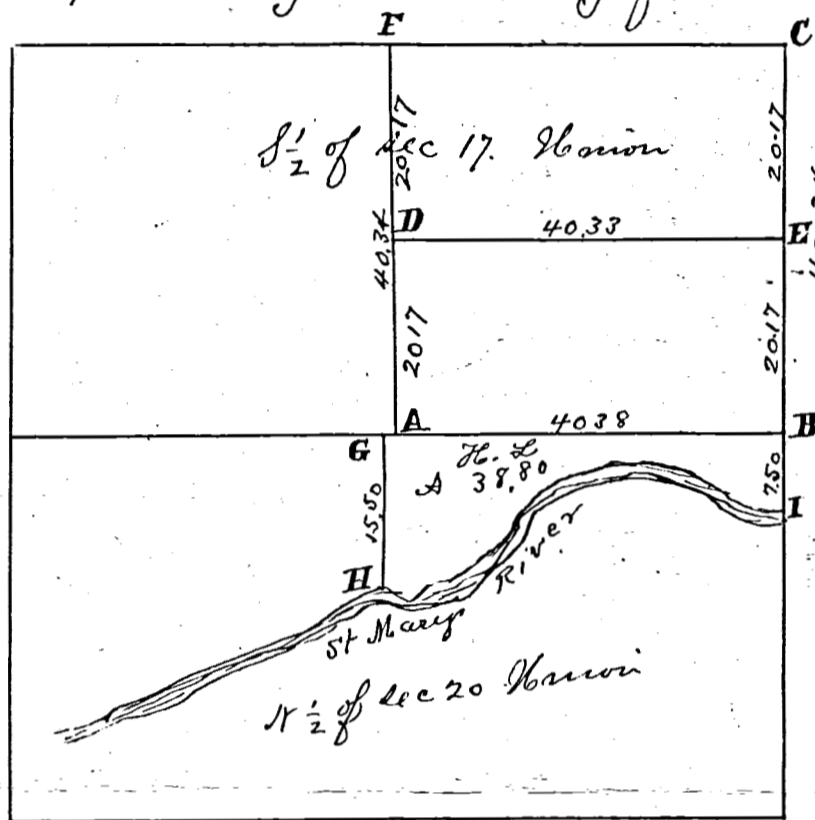
