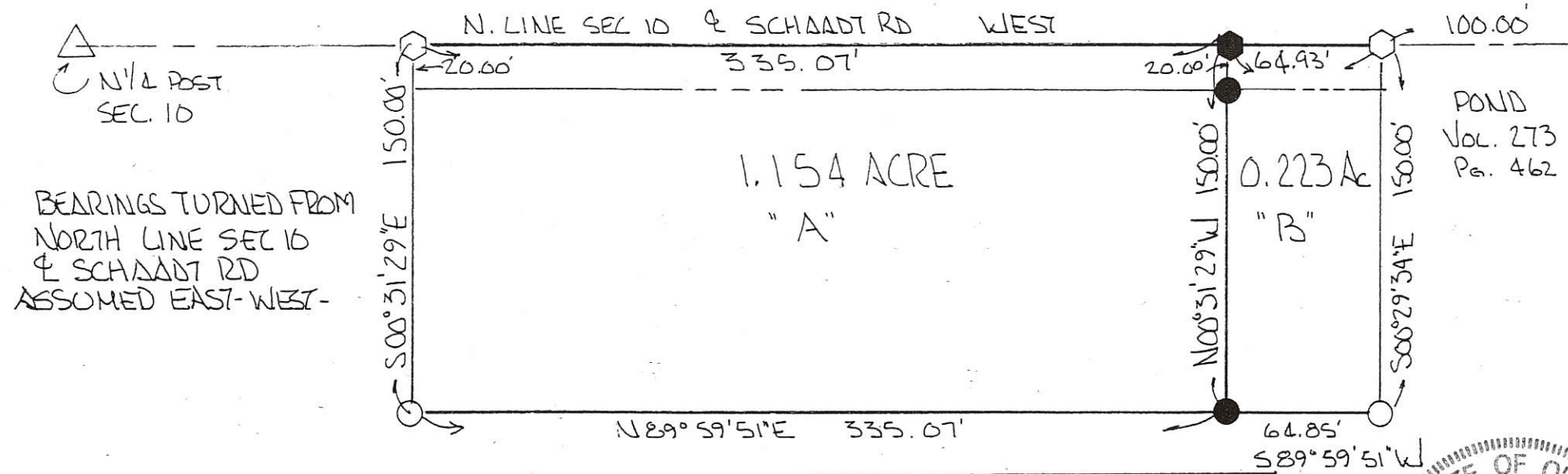


SEC. 10 - LIBERTY TWP.

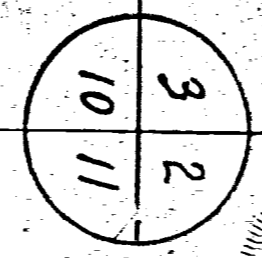
