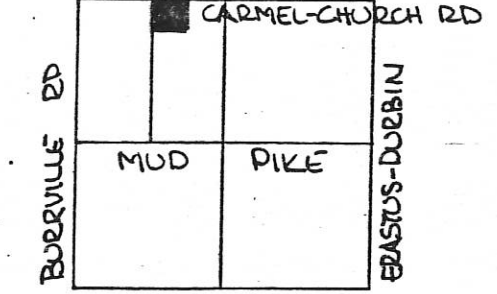

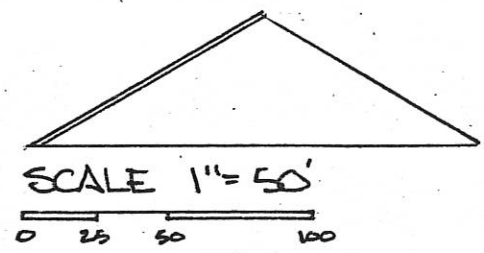

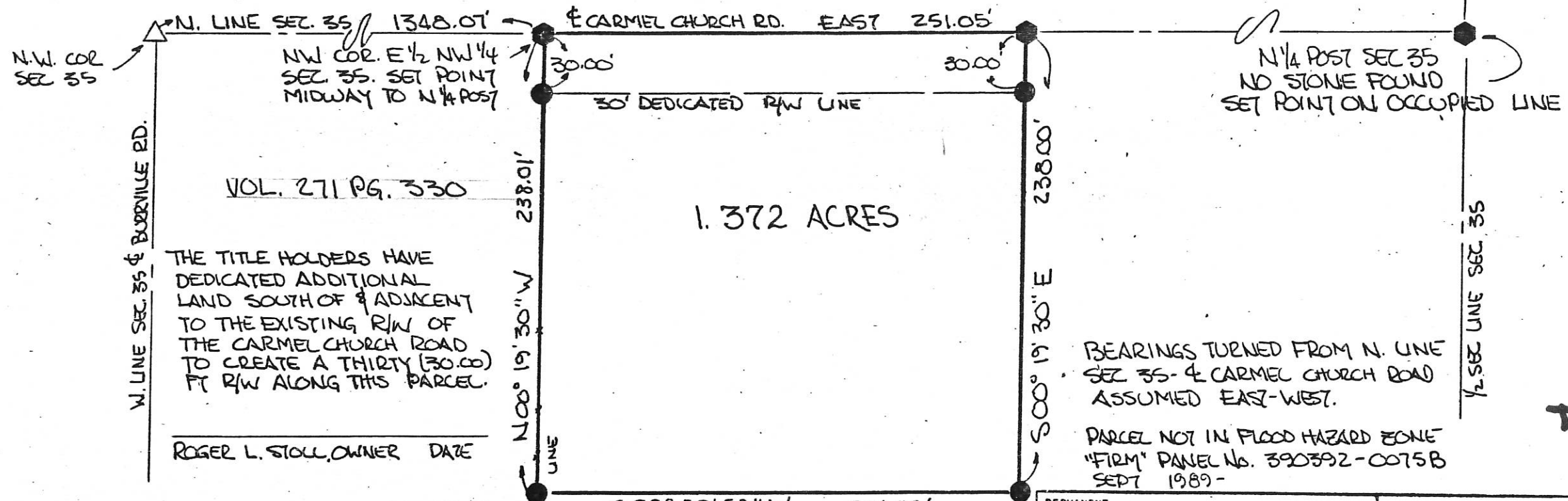
LOCATION PLAT
