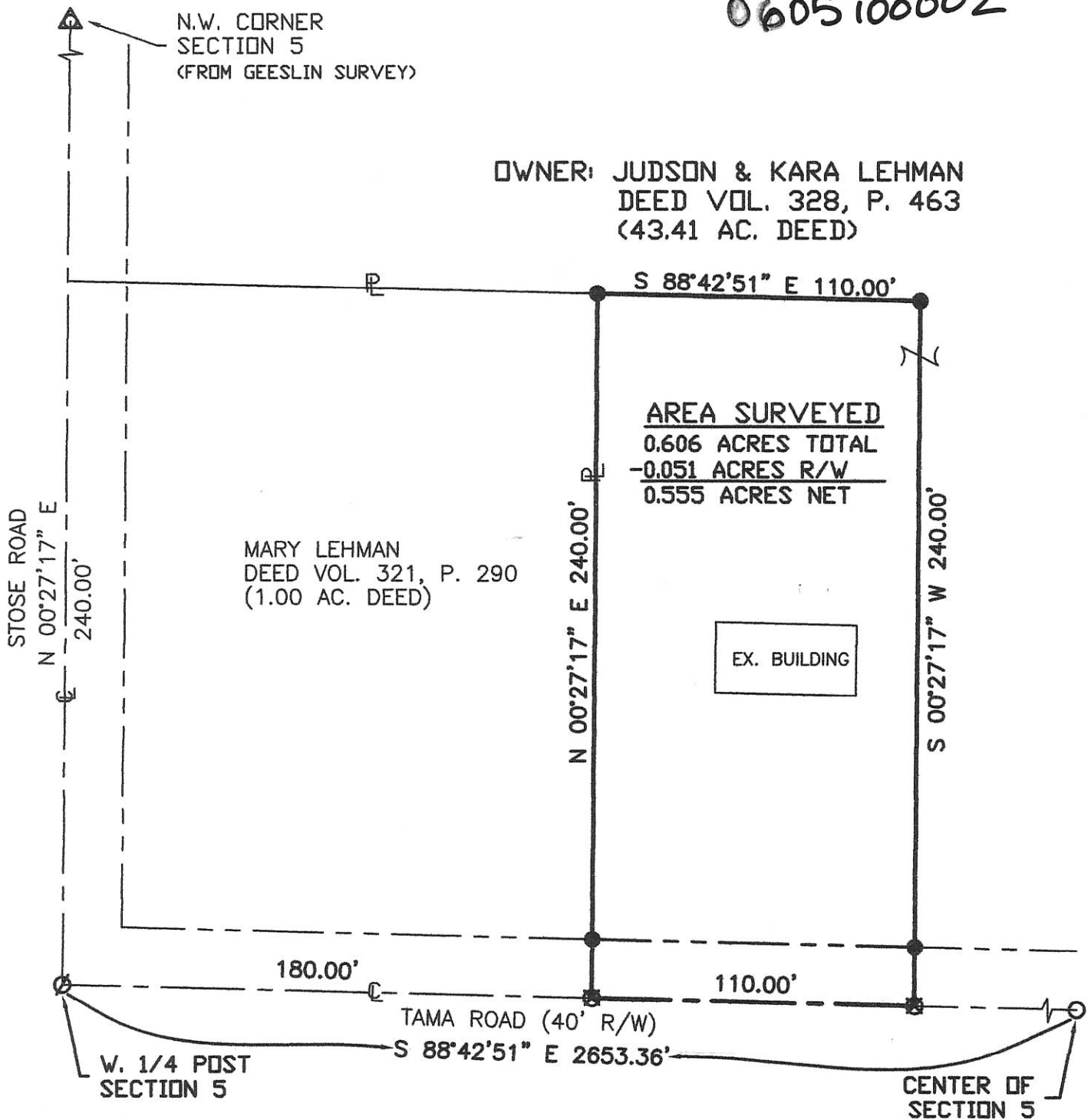
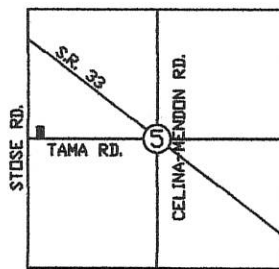

LOCATION MAP

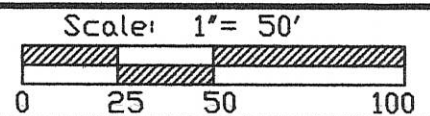
