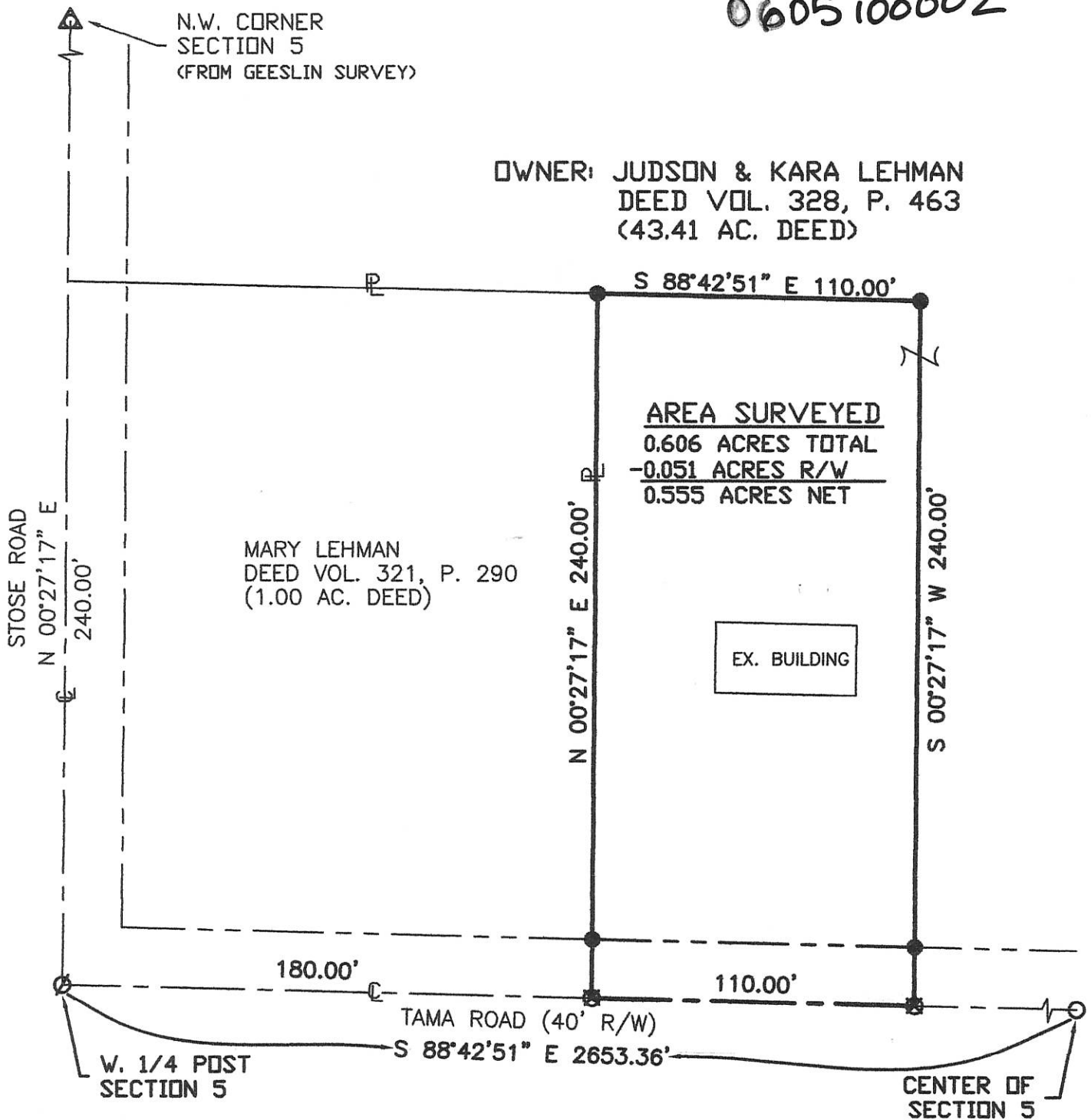
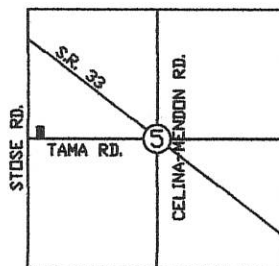

LOCATION MAP

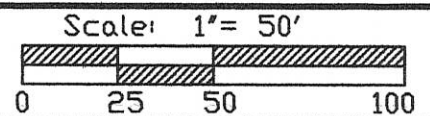
