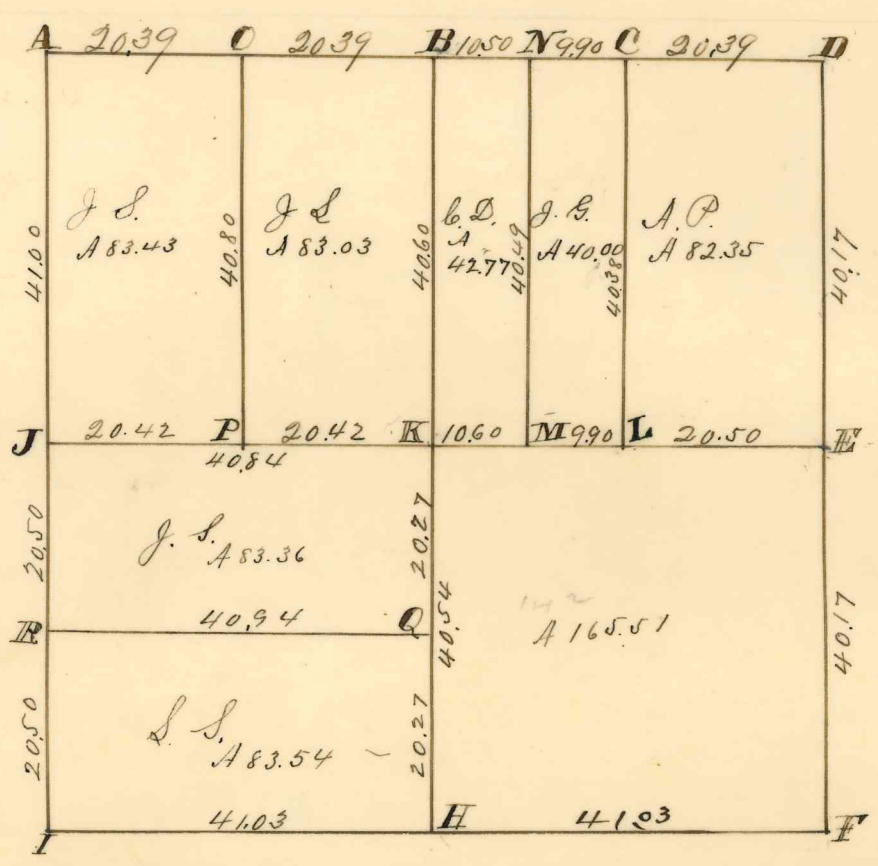

- E Center of South line, Stake, pts & stone 14.10.6 inches 3 3/4 chs East of D and 4 7/10 chs South of B. no trees

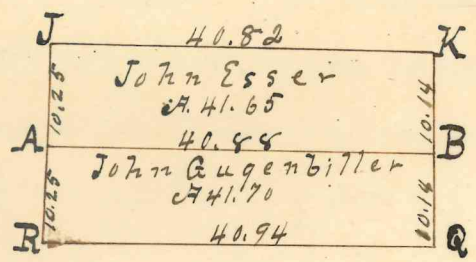
