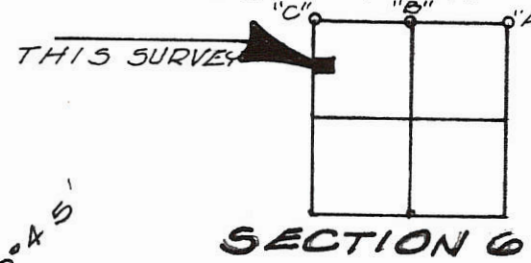


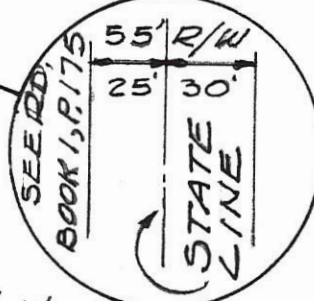
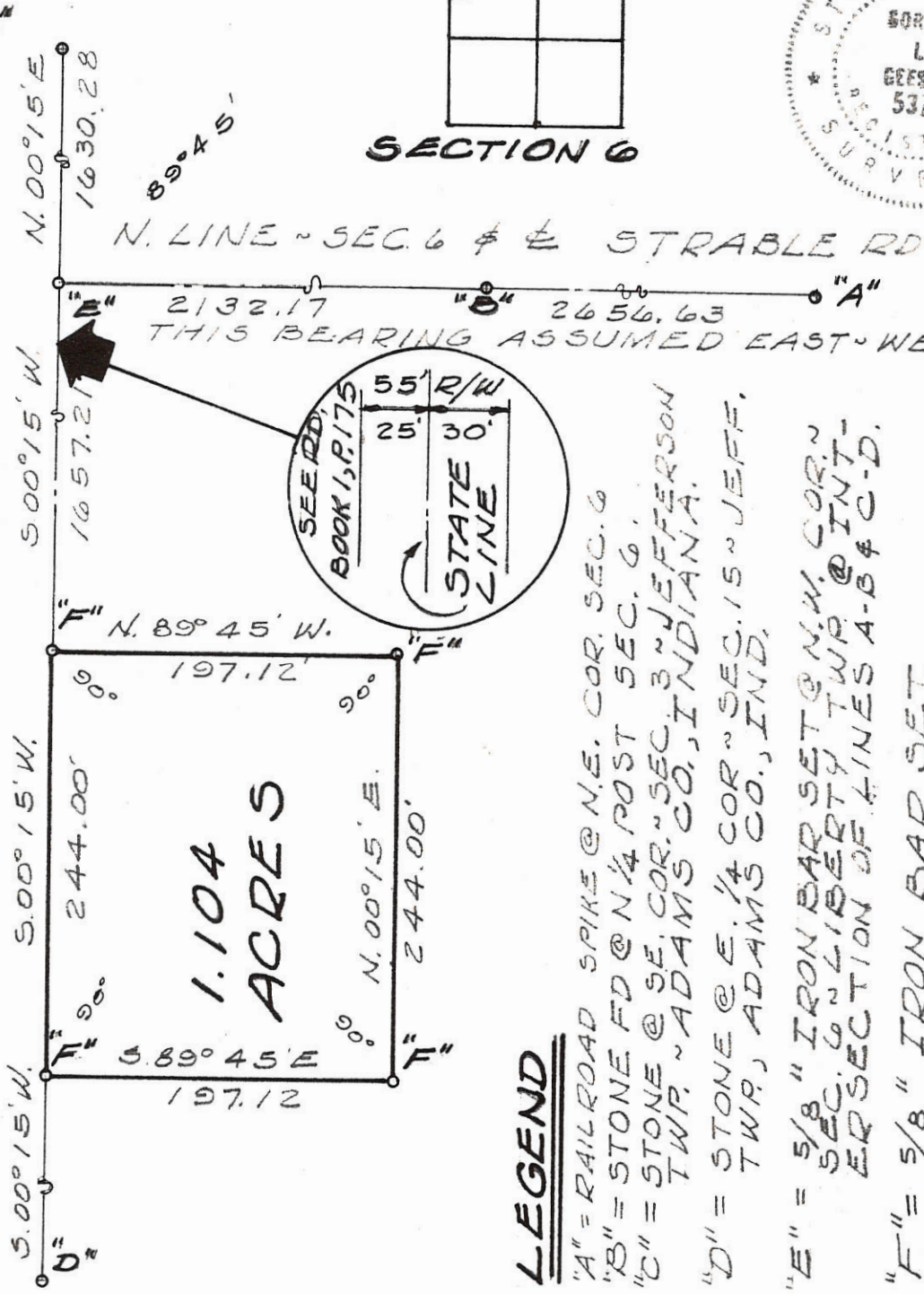
LOCATION SKETCH

INDIANA ~ OHIO LINE ROAD



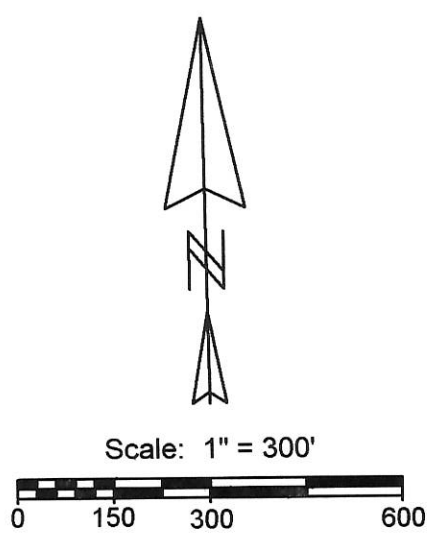

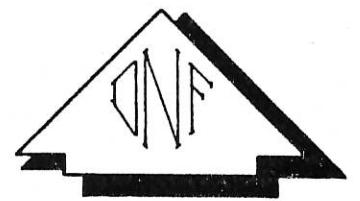

Thence run West 7 1/10 chs to S.W. corner of plat of 5.776 acres to a stake, Cottonwood 7 S 82 E 52. Thence N 7 1/10 chs to the N.E. corner of sec 7 1/10 chs W of N.E. corner of section. Stake, Burr oak 10 N 53 W 49. Surveyed for L. Byer, Oct 30, 1867. At the S.W. corner of the N.W. 1/4 of sec 5, T4 S. R1 E I find the roots of bearing trees correct, and planted stake, bts stone 13.9.6 inches, from which bears S.W. corner of Lutheran Church 107 1/2 links. 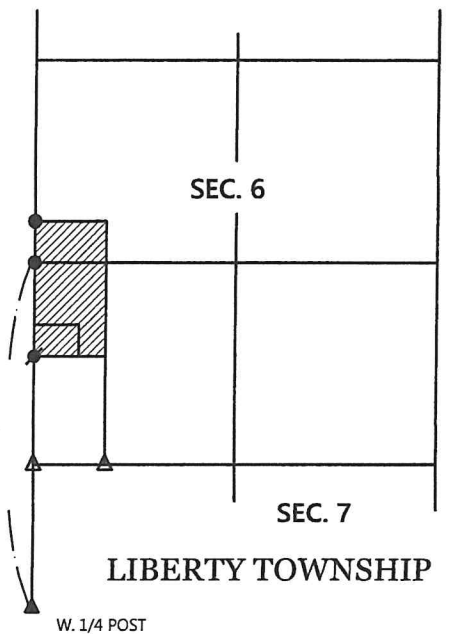
