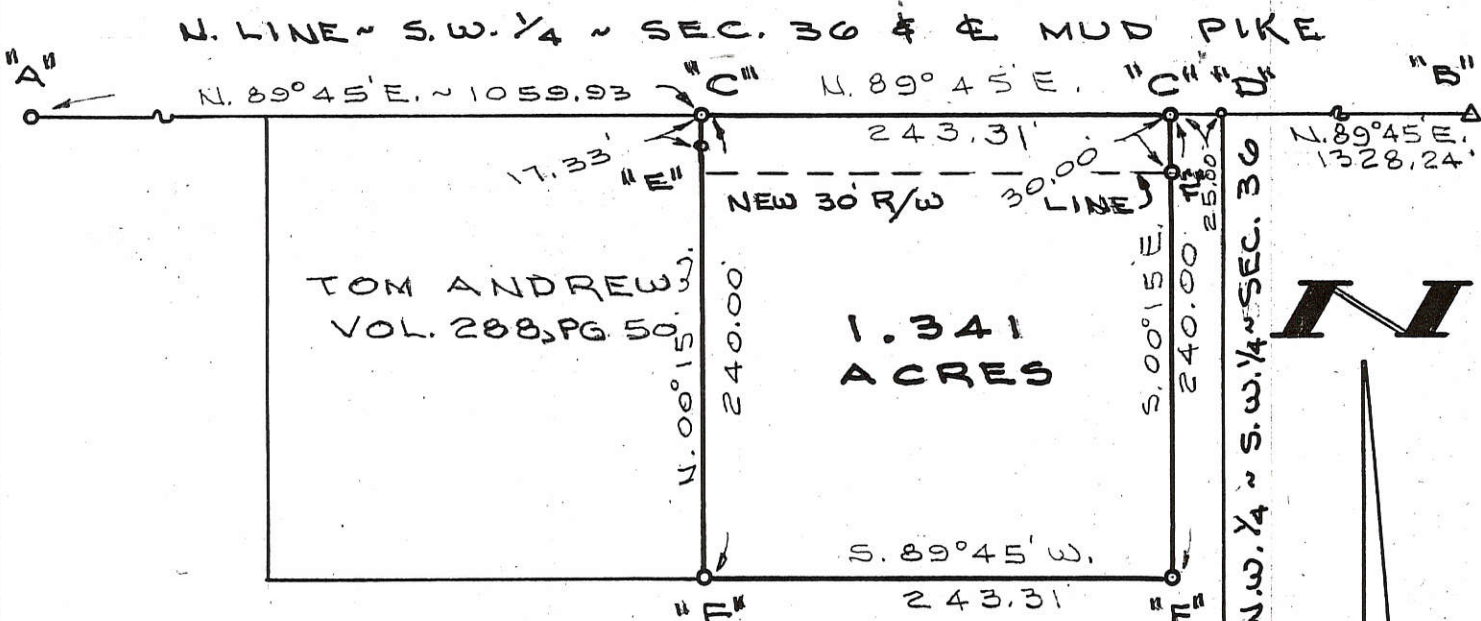
LOCATION SKETCH

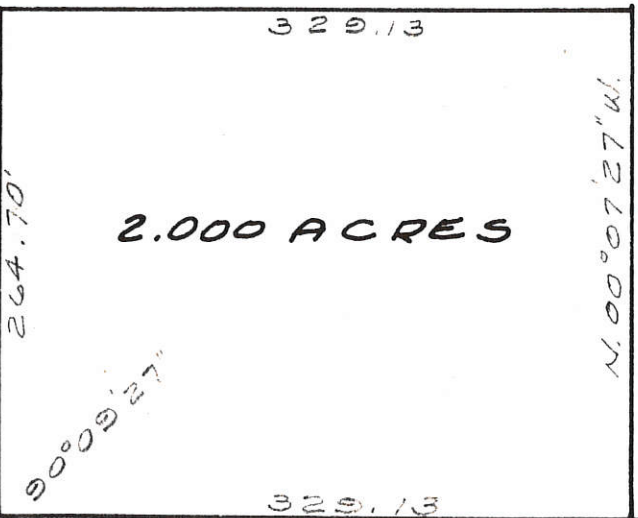
- 1) Dresher's east line is parallel with the west line of the northwest quarter of Section 36.

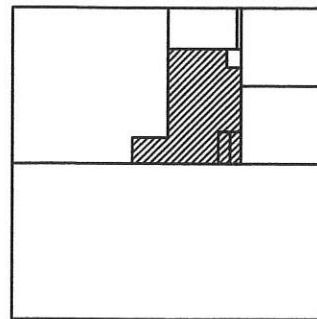
