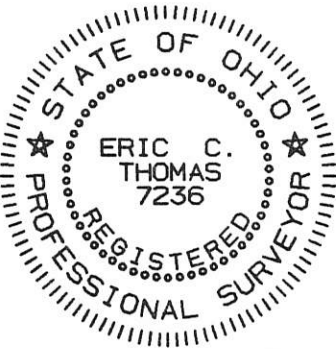


LOCATION MAP

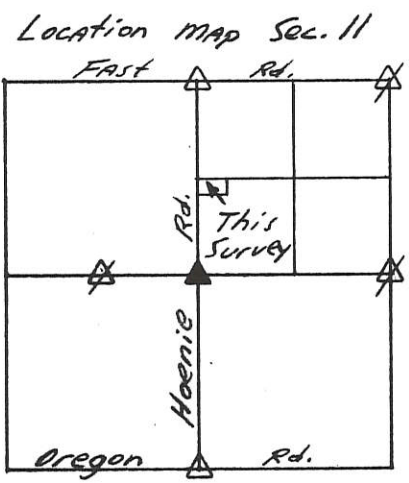
